Names of Patterns.

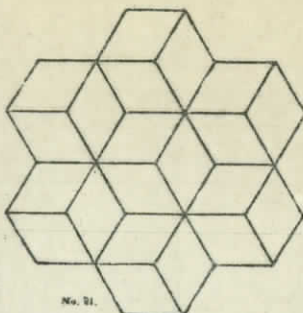
