

# Attractive Applique Patchwork Designs with Border

Applique patchwork or laid work, as it was called in the early days of its appearance, is done by placing pieces of colored material cut in motifs of the design on a background of plain material and securing them with fine stitches. In planning our selection of quilts, we have made a special effort to get outlines easily applied without losing any of the attractiveness and beauty of the design.




## DIRECTIONS FOR PAPER PATTERNS

We furnish patterns of all applique designs stamped on paper for tracing. A sheet of tracing paper is included with every pattern. These patterns consist of: (1) a complete full-sized block and border design, which is to be traced on material for background; (2) patterns of the motifs or parts of the design, such as flowers, leaves, stems, etc., which are to be cut out of the colored applique material. Each motive is numbered, and a corresponding number will be found on the part of background design to which it is to be applied. Price of paper pattern, 50c.

We also furnish these designs stamped on best grade of muslin or sateen. When ordering, be sure to state which is desired. Material for plain blocks and strips are included in the price given under the number of the design. The colored applique cloth is priced separately and is of the best color-fast material. See price under each number.

## No. 6018—POMEGRANATE

This gorgeous old-fashioned pomegranate design, with its simple outlines, always appeals to the quilter.

Five appliqued and four plain sixteen-inch squares, with a twelve-inch appliqued border, make a quilt 72 x 72 inches.

The following colors are used for the applique flowers: green for the center, next apricot, then dark yellow, and light yellow. The leaves and stem are green.

The lines of this design are especially good to follow for quilting, while for the plain squares a simple conventional design should be used.

**No. 6018**—Five sixteen-inch squares and twelve-inch border stamped on best muslin, with four plain squares and paper pattern for applique parts, **\$2.75**; or on sateen, **\$3.75**. Colored applique material, **\$2.50**. Paper pattern, **50c**.

## No. 6056—ROSE OF SHARON

This is not only an old favorite, but continues to be a favorite among modern quilt-makers. It hardly needs any suggestions as to colors, for the very name Rose of Sharon suggests rose and lavender for flowers and buds, with green for stem and leaves.


Fifteen twelve-inch appliqued squares and fifteen twelve-inch plain squares with an eight-inch applique border make a quilt 76 x 88.

The quilting should be done in a conventional design with border to match.


**No. 6056**—Fifteen twelve-inch squares and eight-inch border stamped on best muslin, with fifteen plain twelve-inch squares and paper pattern for applique parts, **\$3.00**; or on sateen, **\$4.00**. Colored applique material, **\$1.75**. Paper pattern, **50c**.

All colored applique material is of Peter Pan gingham, boil-proof and sun-proof, and guaranteed not to fade.

When quilts are ordered stamped on sateen, which in all instances is \$1.00 more than on muslin, colored applique material will also be of sateen.


## No. 6060—TULIP

Four twenty-four inch applique squares form the center of this handsome quilt. Between the center and the twelve-inch applique border is a four-inch plain strip. This makes the quilt 80 x 80 inches.


The flowers are applied in three shades of either yellow, pink or lavender; yellow and two shades of pink are also often used with splendid effect. For the leaves and stems use two shades of green.

As in all large designs, the quilting is best done by following the lines of applique. For the four-inch strips and the background of the border, use a small geometric design.

**No. 6060.**—Four twenty-four inch squares and twelve-inch border stamped on best muslin, with four four-inch strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$  yards long and paper patterns for applique parts, **\$3.00**, or on saten, **\$4.00**. Colored applique material, **\$2.75**. Paper pattern, **50 cents**.






## QUILTING DESIGNS FOR ALL PURPOSES

Some of these designs are especially adapted for bed-puffs, cushions, chair-backs and many other articles for which quilting is so much in vogue now.



### Description C 718

A combination of embroidered squares and pieced patchwork makes a colorful and attractive quilt.


A shade of one of the colors used for the embroidery should be used in combination with white for the patchwork. A darker shade of the color used for the patchwork is used for the narrow border on the edge.

In the quilt illustrated twenty 12-inch embroidered squares are combined with 4-inch strips and border of patchwork, making a quilt 74x88 inches.


No. C 718. Twenty 12-inch squares stamped on best muslin with all white and colored material needed for patchwork and border, and paper pattern for patchwork, \$4.25; or on sateen, \$5.25.

When ordering mention color preferred.

Any other 12-inch block design may be selected in the place of one shown in the illustration.

## No. C713, CRIB QUILT, 36 x 50

Eight  $7\frac{1}{2}$  x  $7\frac{1}{2}$ -inch squares stamped on best white muslin, with colored and white material to make either plain or pieced alternating blocks, also material for strips, **\$1.75**. The same stamped on fine sateen, **\$2.25**. Perforated patterns of the eight bunnie blocks, **75c**. Colored material may be had in blue or pink. When ordering, state what color desired.


### Quilt Block Designs for Outline Stitch

The designs of the Sunbonnet Babies are stamped on nine inch squares and when worked with the simple outline stitch in one color, will make a delightful quilt for a child's bed.

Nine inch squares, stamped on best muslin, 10c, each; the set, 75c.

On sateen, 15c each; the set, \$1.00.

Perforated pattern, 12, each; the set, 85c.

### No. 6065 PANSY DESIGN

This design may be worked out in two shades of yellow, or two shades of lavender for the applique on flowers and buds, with green for leaves and stems.

White material should be used for the attractive 8-inch border. On this, two rows of scallops are applied in the two shades of either yellow or lavender. The strips between the blocks are of the lighter shade used in the border with connecting squares of white.

The scallop on the border furnishes an excellent quilting design, which can be carried out in rows as on border to the center of the quilt.

No. 6065, size 76 x 92. Twenty 12-inch squares with 8-inch border, stamped on best muslin with paper pattern\* for applique parts,—\$2.50; or on sateen,—\$3.75. Colored applique material, \$3.75. Paper pattern, 50c.

All colored material furnished for our quilt sets is of boil and sun proof Peter Pan Gingham, and of the best grade of sateen.

When ordering, mention color preferred.


We furnish perforated patterns of all our quilting designs. The price and size is given below each design. The patterns are perforated on a very high grade of bond paper, and will last indefinitely. They are transferred to the material by means of stamping powder or stamping wax. It is best to use the powder for stamping articles to be quilted, as any part of the outline not covered by the stitches can be rubbed off with a clean cloth without marring the work. To stamp with powder, place the pattern on the material with the rough side up and secure so that it will not move; cover a soft cloth or poncet with powder and rub over the pattern. Then remove pattern and a clear outline of the design will be on the material. Stamping powder, white or blue, **15c** per box; two boxes, for **25c**.

Stamping wax is used to transfer designs for embroidery work or work where the outline is entirely covered. To stamp, place the pattern on the material with the smooth side up and secure so that it will not move. Take a soft cloth or poncet, moisten with benzine or gasoline, rub over the wax, and then over the pattern; carefully remove the pattern, and the design will be clearly stamped on the material. Stamping wax is made in black, white, and blue, and put up in cakes. Price, **25c**.

No. Q54 to Q59, inclusive, 6 in., 12c each. Set of six designs, 50c. These small blocks when stamped in a row form a good design for 6 or 7 inch border.
