Dark Brown	48 pieces

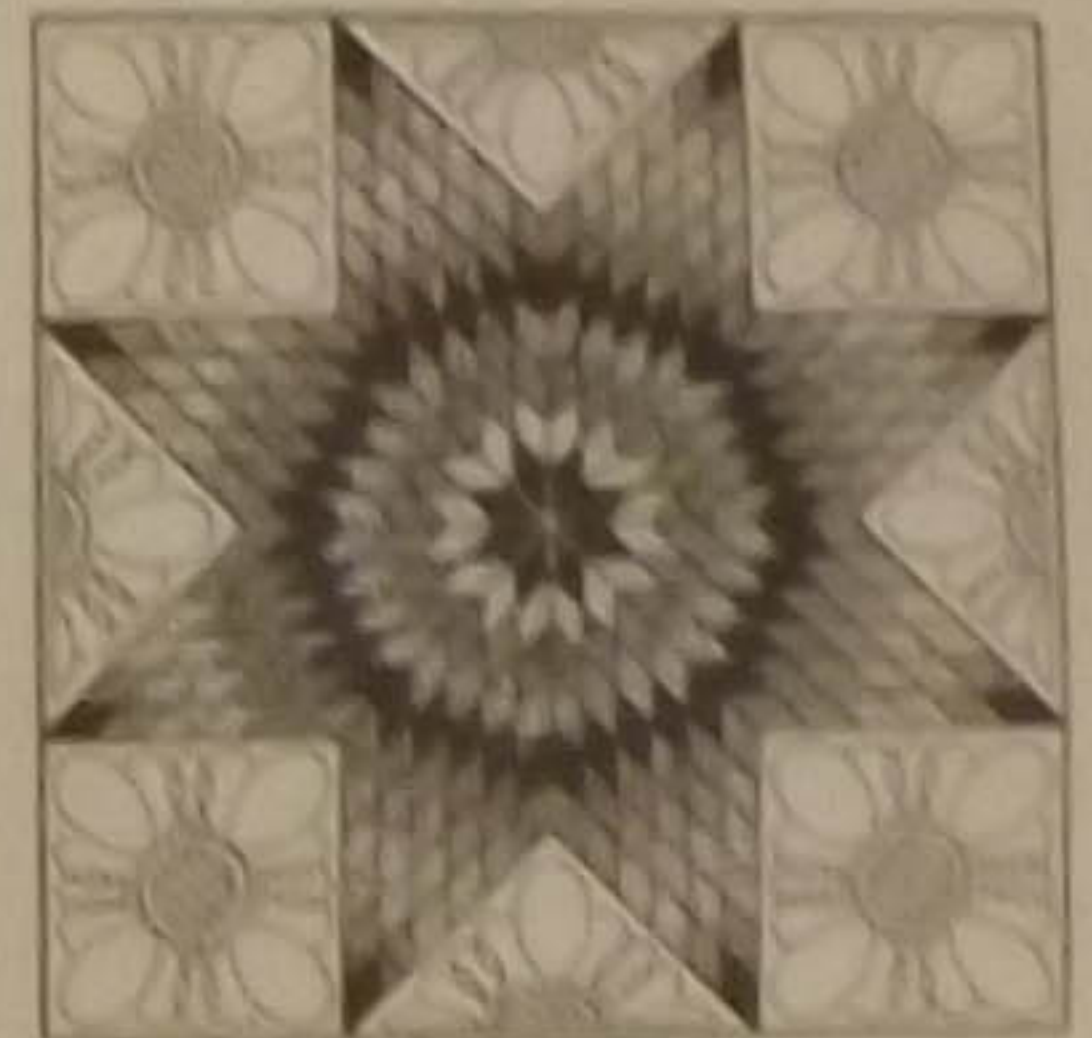
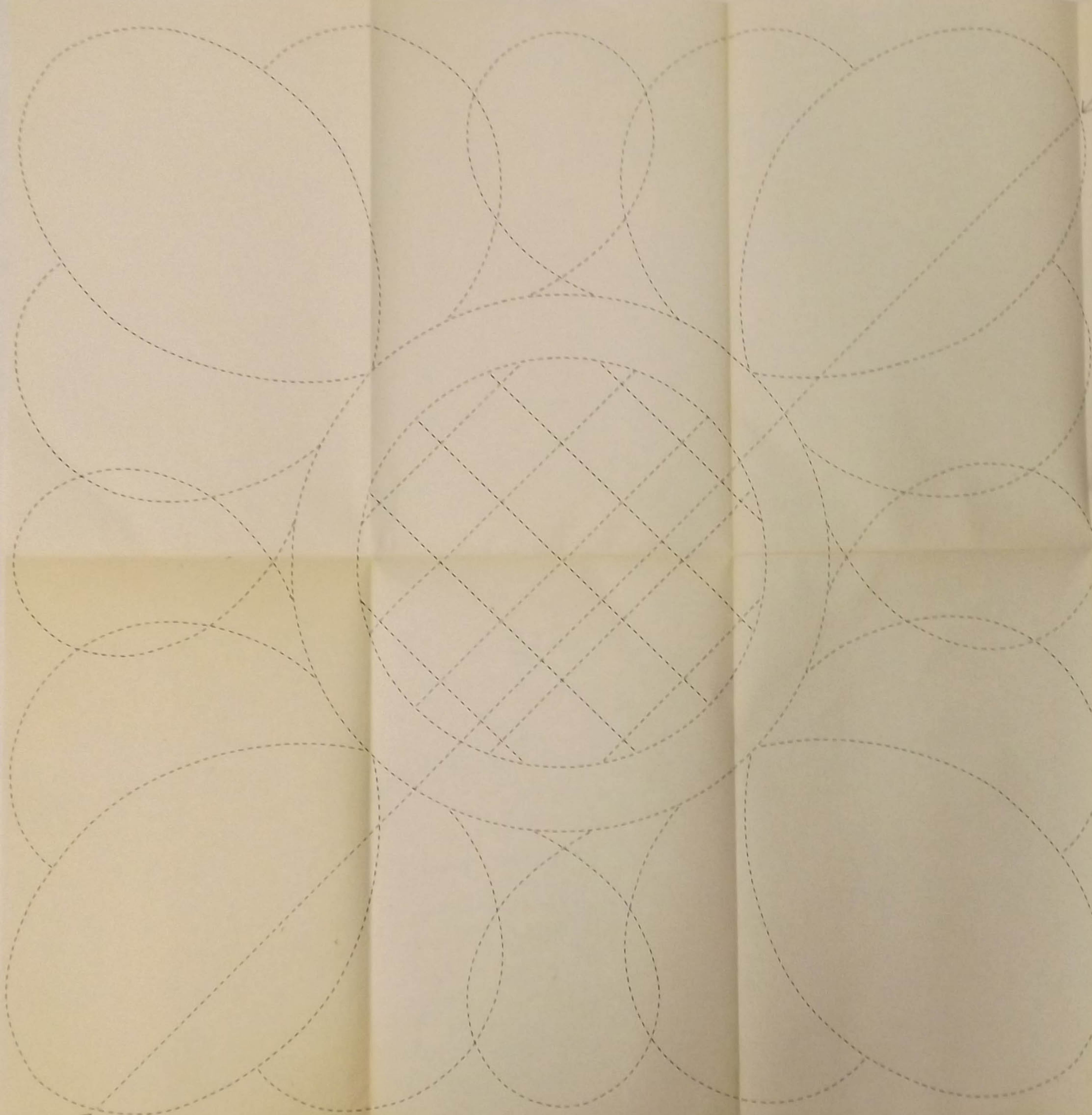
A chart and instructions for setting together to form an exquisitely beautiful blend of colors are on reverse side.

QUILTING DESIGN

These designs are for tracing or perforating, not for stamping.

The most important part of your whole quilt is the quilting. An attractive and pleasing quilting design is what really "makes" a quilt, and gives it its personality as well as beauty. Therefore, too much emphasis cannot be placed on the quilting.

This quilting pattern has been designed especially to match the Lone Star Quilt.

In order to conserve these designs, we suggest that you trace them on fairly heavy paper. This makes a good strong pattern which can be used many times while the original will be in safe keeping and can be used again and again.

TO MAKE YOUR OWN QUILTING PATTERN

Use a piece of tissue paper. With a pencil trace the lines. Trace this on heavy wrapping paper, and to perforate it, run the sewing machine over it, unthreaded. You are now ready to transfer the design to cloth with stamping wax or powder, dry flour or even starch that has been colored with powdered bluing or cocoa. Apply with a wad of cotton.

Before transferring or tracing designs check the exact placement of design on quilt.

Quilting frames, either commercial or homemade, or quilting hoops are needed for a professional looking or good quilting job. They hold the work taut. Follow instructions given with frames or hoops.

Use the complete design for each of the 4 corners except the diagonal line marked with arrows. (Stamp corner squares before perforating diagonal line.)

For the 4 side half squares use the portion of the design up to and including diagonal line marked with arrows. Use the portion indicated by arrows.
