Cut quilt strips apart along broken lines. Match top and bottom line guides at A's and B's, etc. as shown in illustration. Then, pin together, matching lines of design so that design carries through from one section to the other. Baste, easing slightly where necessary to make lines match exactly and being sure at this time, that the design follows through and lines connect properly from one strip to the next. Stitch by machine or, if sewing by hand, use a back stitch or use running stitch with a back stitch every 3 or 4 stitches. Proceed with applique - quilting is done later.

The six strand floss may easily be separated into one or more strands. Use one strand of floss for attaching the applique patches. For convenience in working cut the floss into 36" lengths.

APPLIQUES - (BORDER - bias strips): Pin in place with center of bias strip along line guides. Turn under raw ends and miter at corners. Slip stitch edge to foundation, using 1 strand of matching floss.

APPLIQUES - (PATCHES): Cut out on broken lines in order required. Slash all inside curves to allow for easier turning. Turn under all edges on solid lines, with the exception of edges that fall under a piece that is appliqued later and baste for best results.

Pin or baste in place and slip stitch to foundation in numerical order, using one strand of matching floss.

QUILTING

We recommend Bucilla Quilt Back No. 25001

THE MATCHING QUILT BACK CAN BE ORDERED BY YOUR DEALER TO ASSURE YOUR GETTING THE SAME QUALITY FABRIC AS THE QUILT TOP.

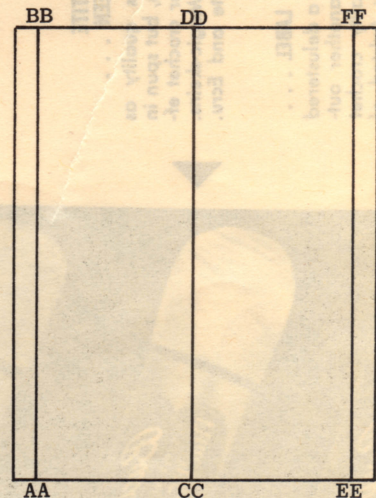
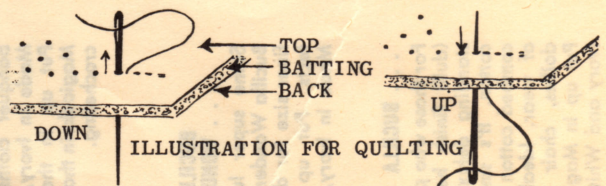
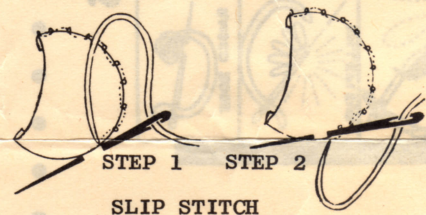
Batting (for padding) is available at all stores in size 81 x 108" and is sufficient to pad the quilt if instructions are followed correctly. Press embroidered quilt top carefully on reverse side. Place batting on wrong side of quilt top using the outside stamped lines as a guide. Cut away excess batting and (if necessary) add strips of batting to the width of quilt completely covering areas between guide lines (it is unnecessary to join cut pieces of batting). Place quilt back over batting and baste all pieces - (top, batting and back) together to prepare for quilting. Use white sewing thread for quilting - do not knot thread to fasten at ends of quilting - take a few stitches through all layers at beginning and ending of thread as this is more secure and neater than a knot.

With a small running or darning stitch sew through layers where dots are indicated or

quilt with conventional quilting stitch which is, one stitch at a time, pushing needle directly down then directly up through all all thicknesses - see illustration. The quilting stitch should be small and the same size on both sides of quilt.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS: Cut material out 1/4" outside stamped lines. Turn edges of top and back in and slip stitch together all around.

We recommend that the quilt be dry cleaned rather than washed unless very carefully done. Washing may make padding lumpy. If washed, extreme care should be taken as rubbing tends to pull padding apart and leave thin spots.
