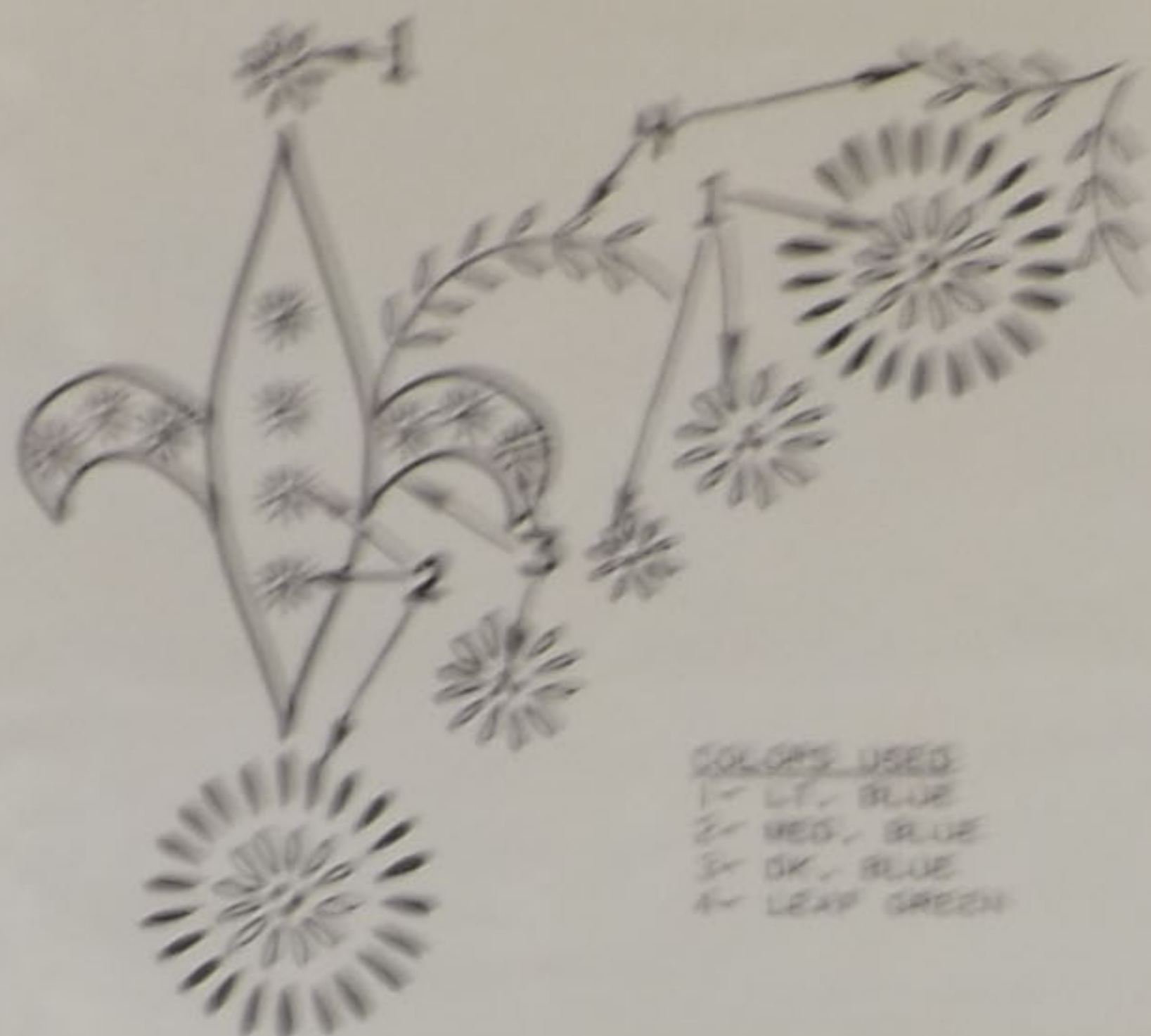

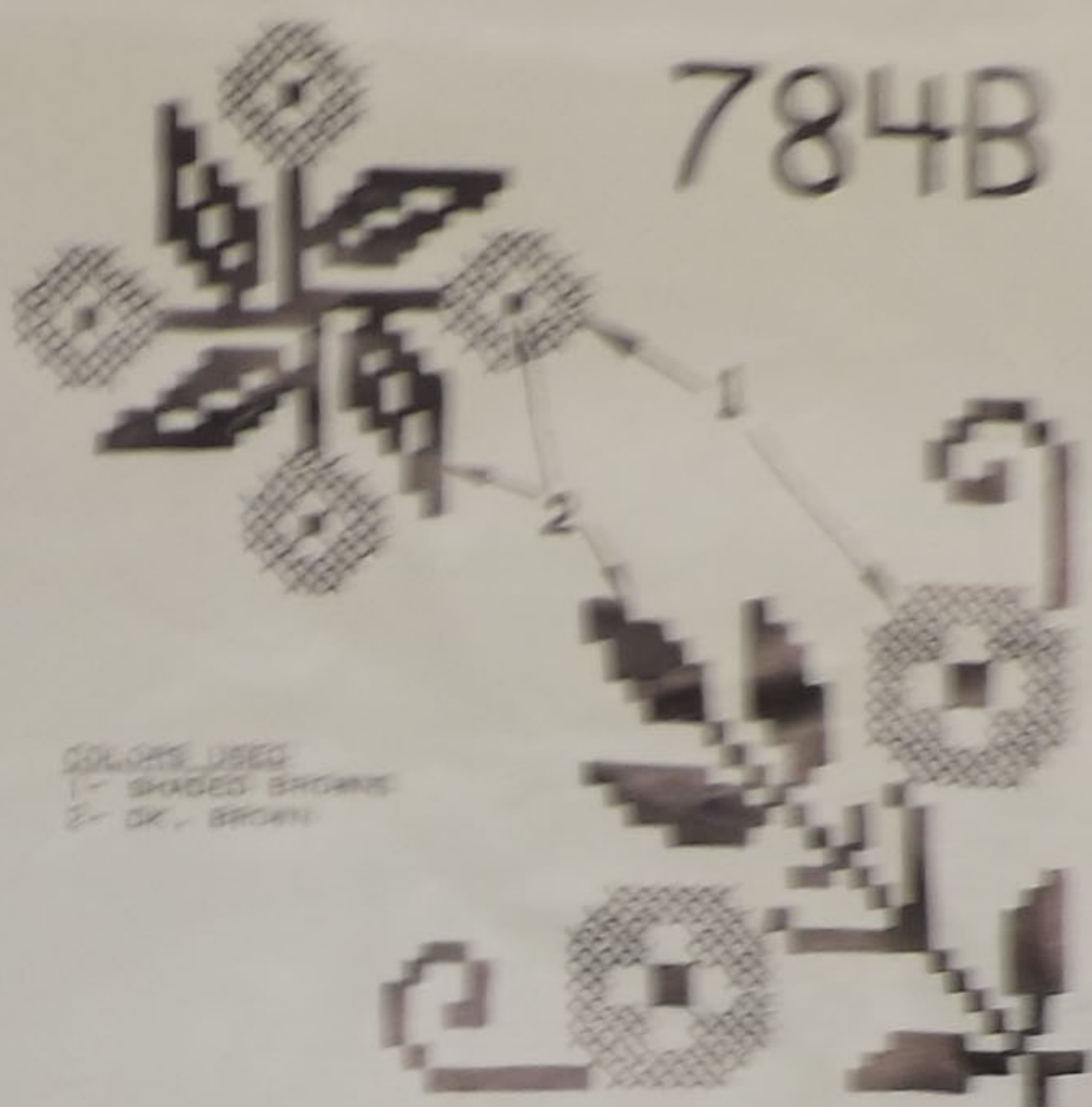

EMBROIDERY INSTRUCTIONS

LARGE FLOWER- OUTSIDE ROW- LOOP STITCH 4 STRANDS
 INSIDE ROW- LOOP STITCH 3 STRANDS. CENTERS-
 FRENCH KNOTS- 2 STRANDS WOUND TWICE AROUND
 NEEDLE. SMALL LOOP STITCH FLOWERS- 3 STRANDS.
 SMALL SINGLE STITCH FLOWERS- 2 STRANDS. FLOWER
 DETAILS- OUTLINE STITCH 2 STRANDS. STEMS-
 OUTLINE STITCH 1 STRAND. LEAVES- LOOP STITCH
 2 STRANDS.

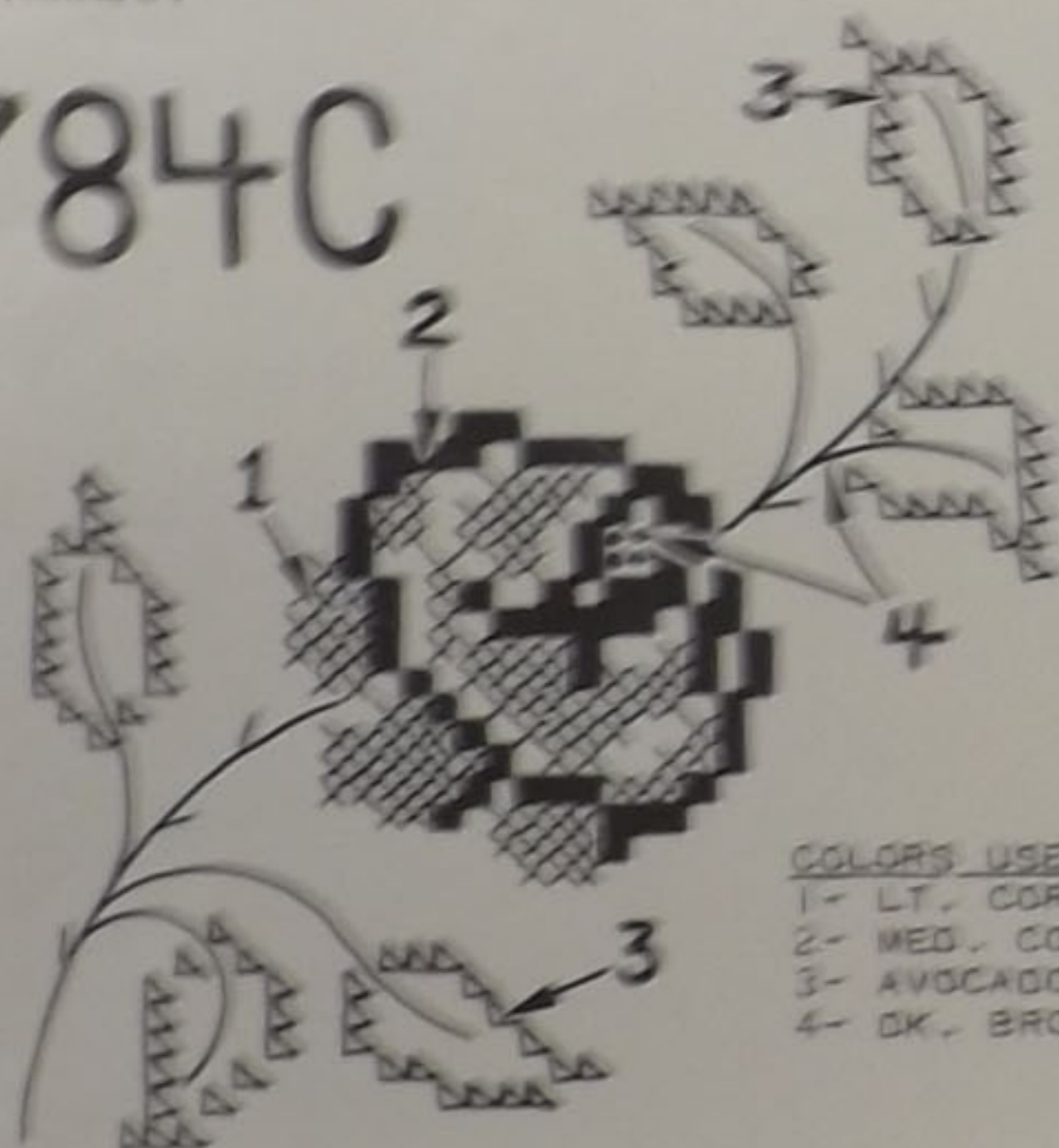

EMBROIDERY INSTRUCTIONS

ALL CROSS STITCH- 3 STRANDS. EMBROIDER FIRST
 HALF OF ALL THE CROSSES IN ONE DIRECTION AND
 SECOND HALF IN THE OPPOSITE DIRECTION. THIS
 WILL GIVE A SMOOTH PROFESSIONAL LOOK TO YOUR
 FINISHED WORK.

EMBROIDERY INSTRUCTIONS

ALL CROSS STITCH- 3 STRANDS. STEMS- OUTLINE
 STITCH 1 STRAND. FRENCH KNOTS- 2 STRANDS WOUND
 TWICE AROUND NEEDLE. EMBROIDER FIRST HALF
 OF ALL THE CROSSES IN ONE DIRECTION AND
 THE SECOND HALF IN THE OPPOSITE DIRECTION.
 THIS WILL GIVE A SMOOTH PROFESSIONAL LOOK
 TO YOUR FINISHED WORK.

STITCH DETAILS



DIRECTION FOR MAKING QUILTS

MEASURE YOUR BED AND DECIDE HOW MANY SQUARES YOU
 WILL NEED FOR THE EFFECT YOU WANT TO HAVE WHETHER
 IT IS TO BE QUILTED ON TOP OF BED ONLY WITH A RUF-
 FLED SKIRT OF PLAIN MATERIAL TO THE FLOOR OR TO
 HANG OVER SIDES AND COVER PILLOWS AS A COVERLET
 USED WITH A DUST RUFFLE.
 EMBROIDER SQUARES SEPARATELY FOLLOWING EMBROIDERY
 INSTRUCTIONS. THEY MAY BE ASSEMBLED INTO A QUILT
 BY SEWING SQUARES INTO STRIPS, THEN SEWING STRIPS
 TOGETHER. SEW SEAMS EVENLY BY HAND OR MACHINE.
 PRESS ALL SEAMS FOR A SMOOTHER APPEARANCE.
 LAY BACKING OUT SMOOTHLY THEN THE FILLING OVER IT
 AND THE EMBROIDERED TOP PIECE. SECURE ALL THREE
 LAYERS TOGETHER WITH AS MANY PINS AS NECESSARY TO
 KEEP FROM SHIFTING. START AT CENTER. RUN BASTINGS
 OUT TO ALL 4 SIDES AND ACROSS FROM CORNER TO COR-
 NER DIAGONALLY. BASTE EDGES TOGETHER AND REMOVE
 PINS. A QUILTING FRAME OR HOOP MAY BE USED OR
 QUILTING MAY BE DONE BY HAND. USE A SHORT SHARP
 QUILTING NEEDLE AND EXTRA STRONG WHITE COTTON
 THREAD. TAKE SMALL RUNNING OR BACK STITCHES
 THROUGH ALL THREE THICKNESSES OF MATERIAL COVER-
 ING EACH STAMPED DOT. DO NOT KNOT THE THREAD. 2
 OR 3 TINY BACK STITCHES WILL HOLD IT. QUILT ALONG
 SEAM LINES FIRST. ALWAYS WORKING FROM CENTER TO-
 WARD YOU THEN TOWARD OPPOSITE SIDE. NEXT FROM
 CENTER TO RIGHT AND FROM CENTER TO LEFT SIDE TO
 KEEP AN EVEN APPEARANCE. WHEN ALL SEAM LINES ARE
 QUILTED THEN QUILT THE EMBROIDERED SQUARES AS
 STAMPED IN DOTS. COVERING EACH DOT. WHEN ALL
 QUILTING IS FINISHED BIND AROUND EDGE WITH BIAS
 BINDING OF DESIRED WIDTH AND COLOR.
