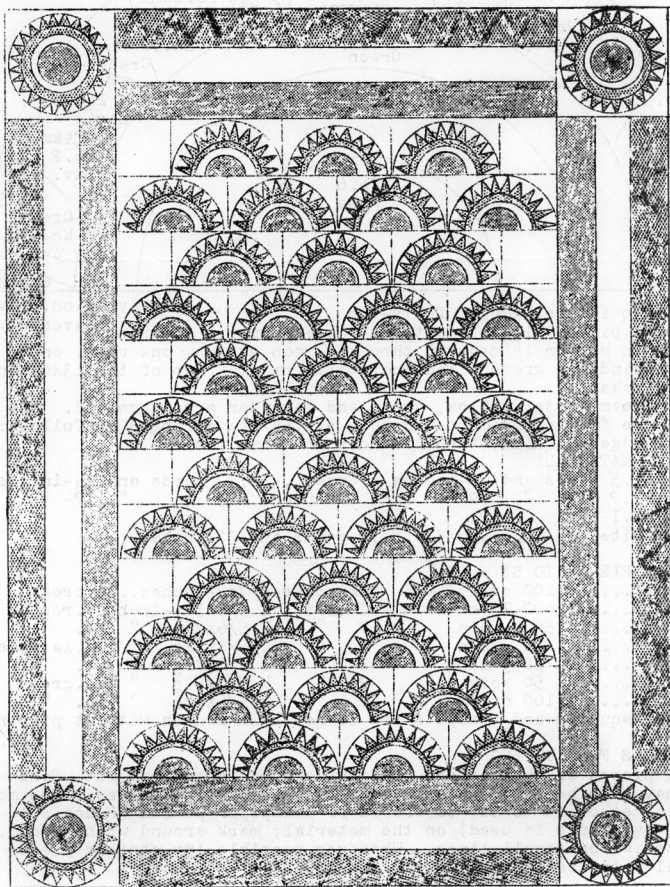


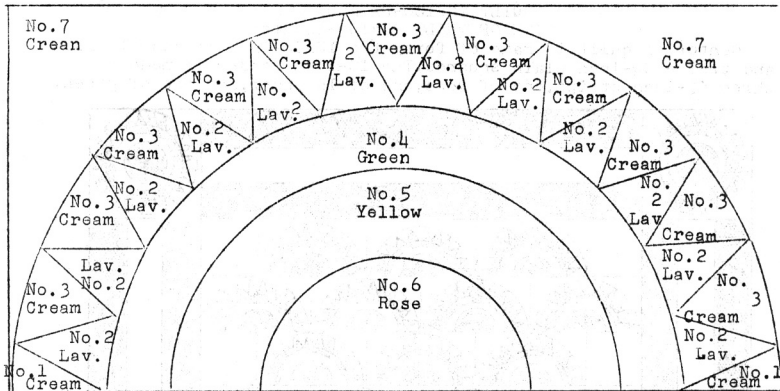
QUILT NO. 130-RAINBOW
 SIZE OF QUILT 78x104-inches

Center of quilt is made of forty-two $13 \times 6\frac{1}{2}$ -inch pieced blocks, and twelve $6\frac{1}{2}$ -inch plain squares. The 13-inch border is made of three $4\frac{1}{2}$ -inch strips, one of rose, one of lavender, and one of green.



Each corner is made of two of the $13 \times 6\frac{1}{2}$ -inch pieced blocks.
 COLORS: Cream, rose, yellow, green, and lavender are suggested. See color chart for arrangement of colors. Border strips are arranged as follows: green at edge of quilt, then lavender, and then rose.

Center of quilt is made of forty-two $13 \times 6\frac{1}{2}$ inch pieced blocks and twelve $6\frac{1}{2}$ -inch plain squares. Lavender. The 13-inch border is made of three $4\frac{1}{2}$ -inch strips, one rose, one lavender, and one green. Each corner is made of two of the $13 \times 6\frac{1}{2}$ inch pieced blocks.

COLORS: Cream, rose, yellow, green and lavender are suggested. See chart above for arrangement. Border strips are arranged as follows: green at edge of quilt, then lavender and then rose.

AMOUNT OF MATERIAL:

Cream.....5 yards and 27-inches	Green.....3 yards and 24-inches
Rose.....2 " " 9 "	Lavender....3 " " 12- "
Yellow.....1 yard " 24 "	

LINING, white, 81-inch width.....2 yards and 32-inches.

NUMBER OF PIECES TO BE CUT

Piece No.1.....100 cream	12 squares 7×7 -inches....cream
" No.2.....600 lavender	2 strips $4 \frac{5}{6} \times 52\frac{1}{2}$ -inches..rose
" No.3.....550 cream	2 " " $4 \frac{5}{6} \times 78\frac{1}{2}$ " ...
" No.4.....50 green	2 " " $4 \frac{5}{6} \times 52\frac{1}{2}$ " ...lavender
" No.5.....50 yellow	2 " " $4 \frac{5}{6} \times 78\frac{1}{2}$ " ... "
" No.6.....50 rose	2 " " $4 \frac{5}{6} \times 52\frac{1}{2}$ " ...green
" No.7.....100 cream	2 " " $4 \frac{5}{6} \times 78\frac{1}{2}$ " ... "

NOTE: Cut squares and strips first to get full length without piecing.

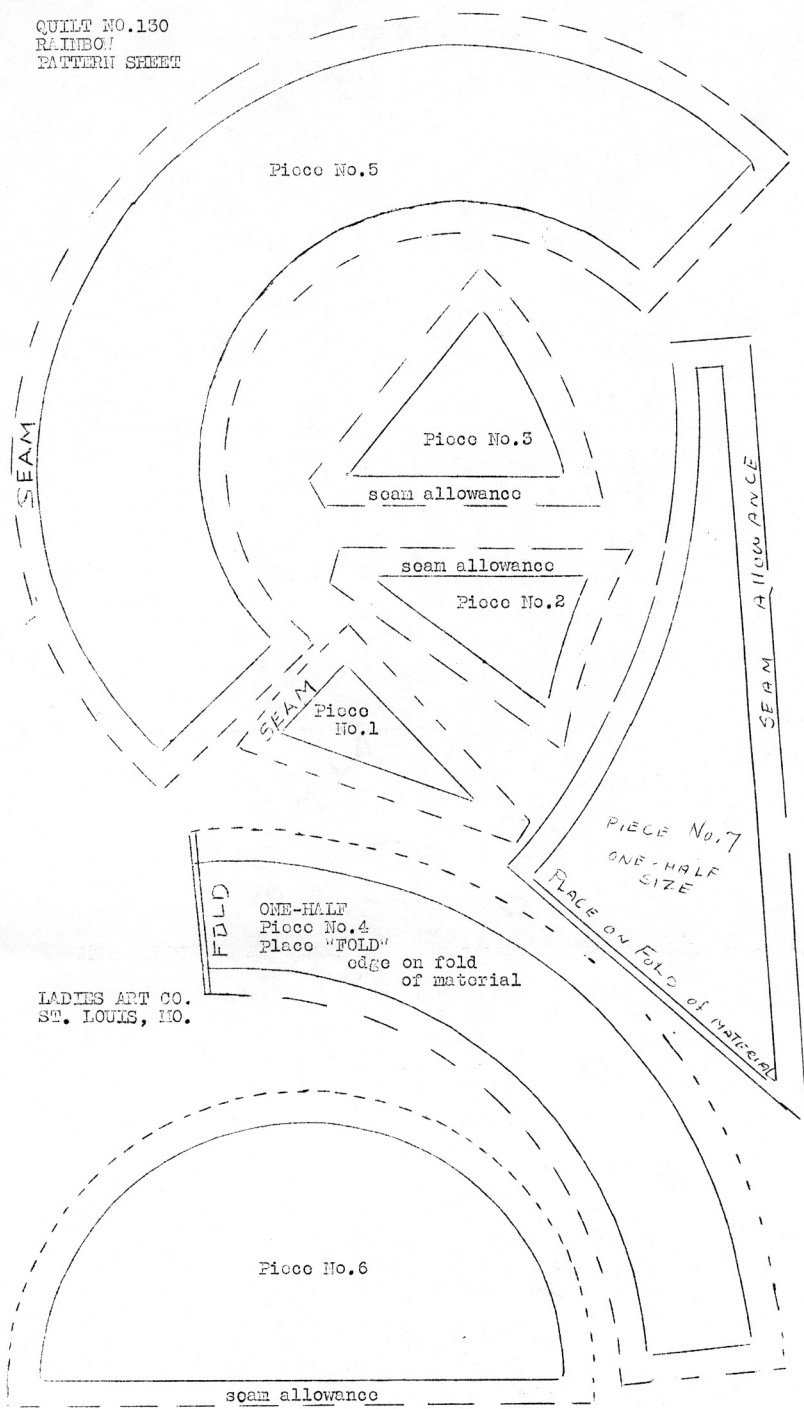
SUGGESTIONS FOR CUTTING

Trace pieces of the pattern on light cardboard and cut out. Sandpaper may also be used. Use these pieces as cutting guides. The most accurate method is to lay cardboard or sandpaper pieces (rough side down if sandpaper is used) on the material; mark around with pencil. Cut material on pencil lines. Whenever possible, lay straight pieces parallel with the threads of the material.

QUILTING

Quilt along all the seams of the piecing. Use our quilting design No. Q82 on border (except corners), and on plain squares.
