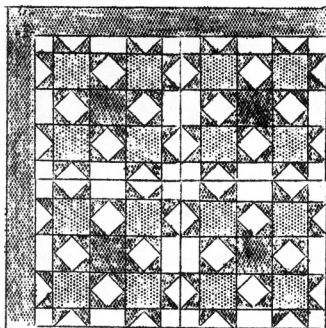


QUILT PATTERN NO. 142--DEVIL'S CLAW--INSTRUCTION SHEET



Corner of Finished Quilt

SIZE OF QUILT, 72x88 inches.

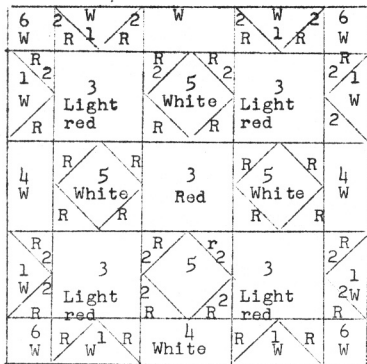
This quilt is made up of twenty 16-inch pieced blocks set four in width and five in length with a 4-inch plain border strip. If desired, this quilt is attractive with each block set to itself making 4-inch plain strips separating each block. In that case the size of the quilt is 84-104 inches. Or alternating a pieced block with a plain block makes an interesting setting.

COLORS

We suggest white, red and light red for this quilt. A print may be substituted for the light red.

AMOUNT OF MATERIAL

White.....2 $\frac{1}{2}$  yards  
 Red.....5 $\frac{1}{2}$  yards  
 Light red...2 $\frac{1}{2}$  yards



NUMBER OF PIECES TO BE CUT

Piece No.1.....160 white  
 " No.2.....640 red  
 " No.3..... 80 light red  
 " No.4..... 20 red  
 " No.5..... 80 white  
 " No.6..... 80 white

2 strips, 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ x72 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches, red  
 2 " , 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ x88 $\frac{1}{2}$  " , "

NOTE: Cut strips first to get full length without piecing.

SUGGESTIONS FOR CUTTING

Trace pieces of the pattern on light cardboard or sandpaper and cut out. Use these patterns as cutting guides. The most accurate method is to lay cardboard or sandpaper pattern on material and mark around with pencil and cut out on pencil lines. Whenever possible lay straight edge of pattern parallel with the threads of the material.

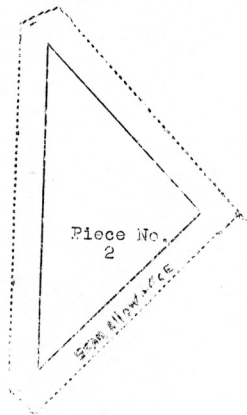
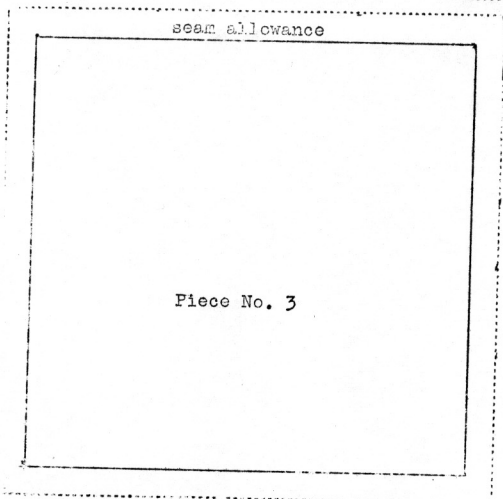
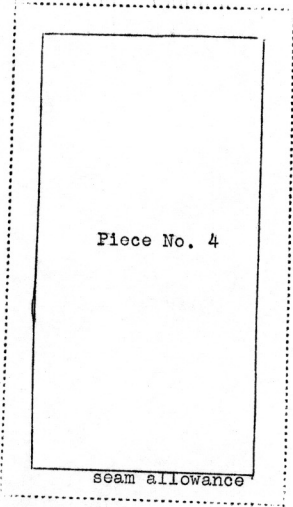
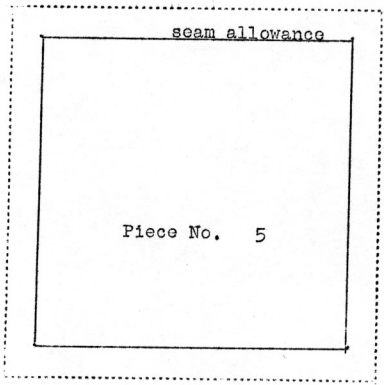
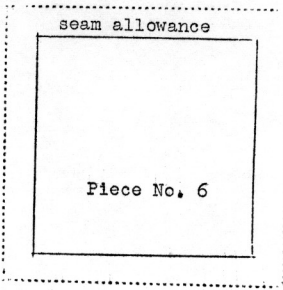
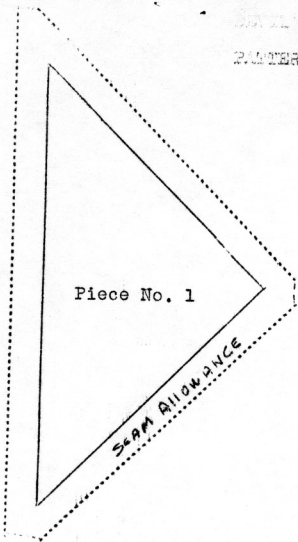
ABBREVIATIONS ON COLOR CHART

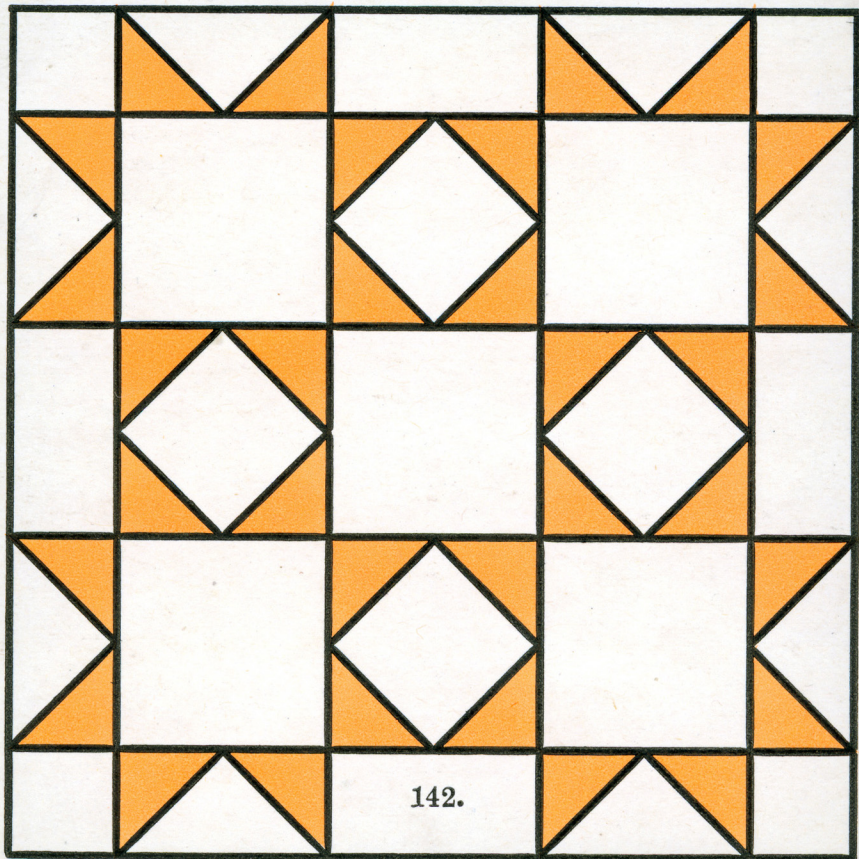
R...Red
