SIZE OF QUILT, 80x92 inches. This quilt is made up of 42 8-inch pieced star centers with 4-inch pieced strips between. The quilt is 6 stars wide and 7 stars long. It is edged with a 2-inch plain strip for the border.

COLORS

White, print and two shades of yellow are suggested for this quilt. Any desired color may be substituted for yellow. See Color Chart for arrangement of pieces and colors.

QUILTING

Quilt along all seams of the piecing. Use our quilting pattern No. Q42(2-inch width) on plain border.

SUGGESTIONS FOR CUTTING

Trace pieces of the patterns on light cardboard or sandpaper and cut out. Use these cardboard or sandpaper pieces as cutting guides. The most accurate method is to lay cardboard or sandpaper pieces (rough side down if using sandpaper) on the material; mark around with pencil and cut out on pencil lines.
