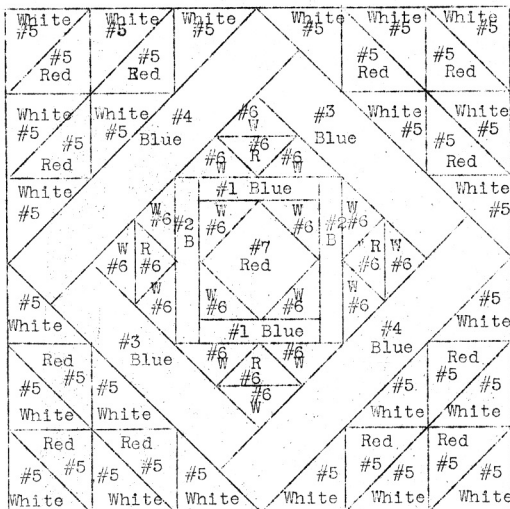


QUILT PATTERN NO.144 - MRS. CLEVELAND'S CHOICE * INSTRUCTION SHEET



SIZE OF QUILT, 72x93 in.

This quilt as illustrated on the other side of this sheet is made up of twenty 15-inch blocks and a border consisting of three 3-inch strips, the outer strip red, the middle one blue and the inner one white.

COLORS
Red, white and blue are suggested as the color scheme for this quilt. See Color Chart at left for arrangement of colors.

MATERIAL REQUIRED
White...4yds.27 inches
Blue...3 " . 9 "
Red...3 "
Total..11yards

W - White; B - Blue; R - Red.

NUMBER OF PIECES TO BE CUT.

Piece #1...	40 - Blue	Piece #5...	480 - White
" #2...	40 - Blue	" #6...	80 - Red
" #3...	40 - Blue	" #6...	320 - White
" #4...	40 - Blue	" #7...	20 - Red
" #5...	240 - Red		

Border strips.

2 strips,	3 $\frac{1}{2}$ x63 $\frac{1}{2}$	- White
2 "	3 $\frac{1}{2}$ x81 $\frac{1}{2}$	- White
2 "	3 $\frac{1}{2}$ x72 $\frac{1}{2}$	- Blue
2 "	3 $\frac{1}{2}$ x87 $\frac{1}{2}$	- Blue
2 "	3 $\frac{1}{2}$ x78 $\frac{1}{2}$	- Red
2 "	3 $\frac{1}{2}$ x93 $\frac{1}{2}$	- Red

QUILTING. Quilt around each piece about $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch or, a little less, from the seams. Use our quilting design No. Q69 over the three border strips.

SUGGESTIONS FOR CUTTING

Trace pieces of the pattern on light cardboard or sandpaper and cut out. Use these cardboard or sandpaper patterns as cutting guides. The most accurate method is to lay pattern on material (rough side down if sandpaper is used) and mark around pattern with pencil. Cut out on pencil lines. Whenever possible lay straight edges of the patterns parallel with the threads of the material.
NOTE. Cut long border strips first in order to get full length without piecing.

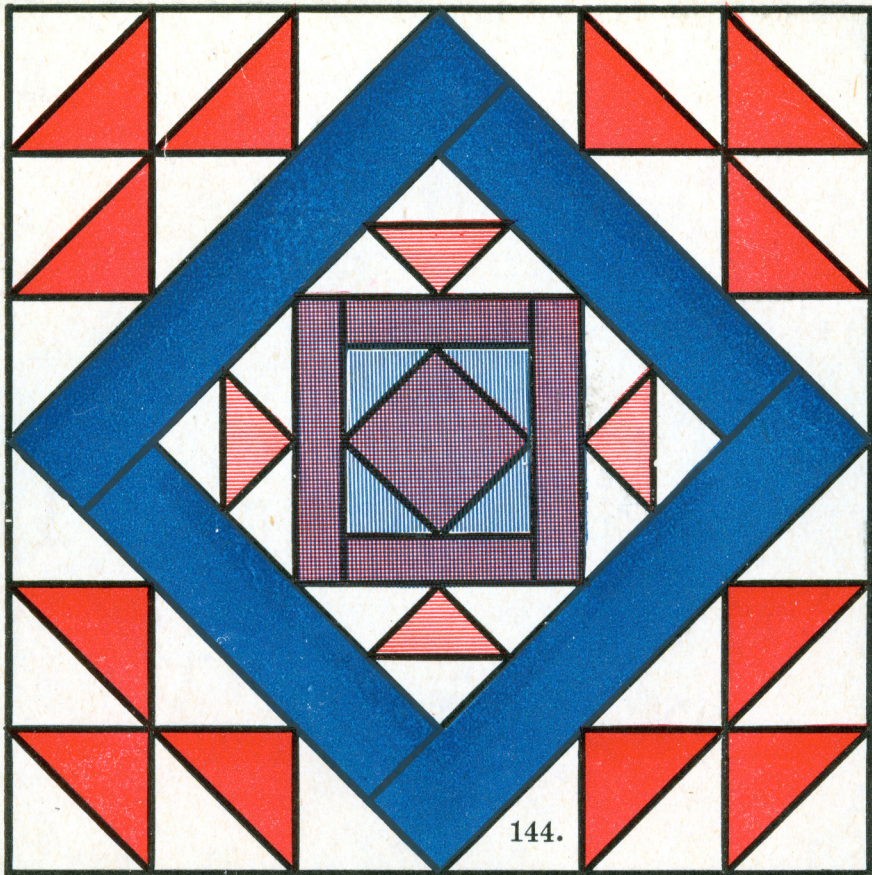
