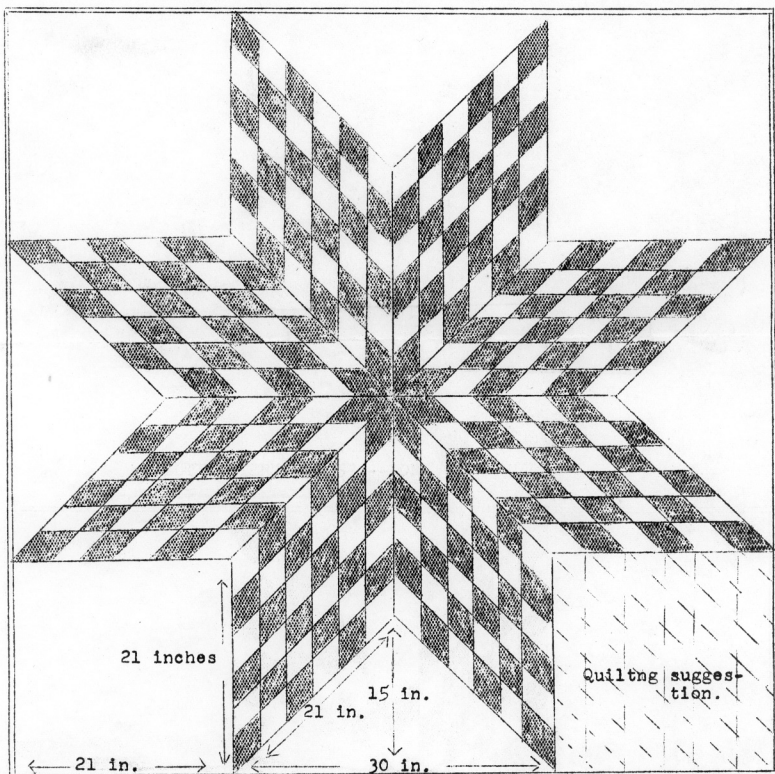
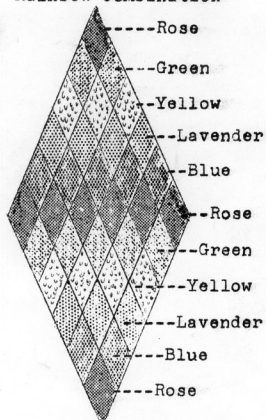


QUILT PATTERN NO. 530--LONE STAR QUILT



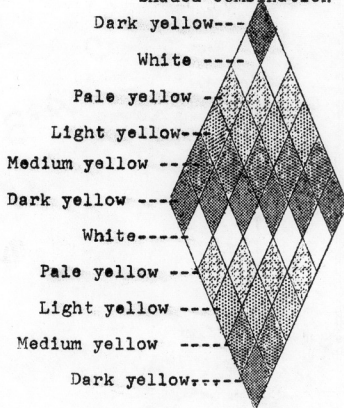
Size of Quilt, 72x72 in.

INSTRUCTION SHEET--LONE STAR QUILT--No.530.

SIZE OF QUILT, 72x72 inches.

This quilt is made of 288 small diamonds, four plain squares and four plain triangles. The small pieced diamonds are pieced into eight large diamonds each of which consist of 36 small diamonds.

COLORS

For this quilt, we suggest 3 combinations:(1) the two color combination of a dark and light color; (2) the rainbow combination of rose, blue lavender, yellow and green; or (3)shaded color combination. We use yellow as an example, any color may be substituted. See illustrations for arrangement of colors.

AMOUNT OF MATERIAL

White....for 4 squares and 4 large triangles.....2 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards of 39 in. material.

Colors. for the small triangles, one yard of 36 inch material will make approximately 77 small triangles. Divide the amount of pieces required into 77 for amount of yards for each color. Example...1 $\frac{1}{4}$ small triangles will require 2 yards and 3 inches.

NUMBER OF PIECES TO BE CUT

Two Color Combination

Piece No.1....1 $\frac{1}{4}$ dark color
" No.1....1 $\frac{1}{4}$ light color

Rainbow Combination

Piece No.1....6 $\frac{1}{4}$ rose
" No.1....56 blue
" No.1....56 lavender
" No.1....56 yellow
" No.1....56 yellow
" No.1....56 green

Shaded Color Combination

Piece No.1....6 $\frac{1}{4}$ Dark yellow
" No.1....56 medium yellow
" No.1....56 light yellow
" No.1....56 pale yellow
" No.1....56 white

4 squares....22x22 inches(seams allowed)

4 triangles...31 inch base, 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches in height and 22 inches on each side(seams allowed)

NOTE: Cut this material after assembling the large pieced diamonds so as to be sure of the size of the sides of the assembled diamonds corresponds with the size of the squares and triangles of plain material.

SUGGESTIONS FOR CUTTING

Trace pieces of the pattern on light cardboard or sandpaper and cut out. Use these cardboard or sandpaper pieces as cutting guides. The most accurate method is to lay cardboard or sandpaper pieces (rough side down) on the material; mark around with pencil and cut out on pencil lines. Be sure to lay stright edges of the pattern paralled with the threads of the material.

DIRECTIONS FOR ASSEMBLING DIAMONDS

First sew diamonds in strips. Each strip has six diamonds and the color combination. Then sew these strips(six strips) together forming the large diamond of 36 pieces. Then sew the eight diamonds together forming the LONE STAR.

QUILTING.

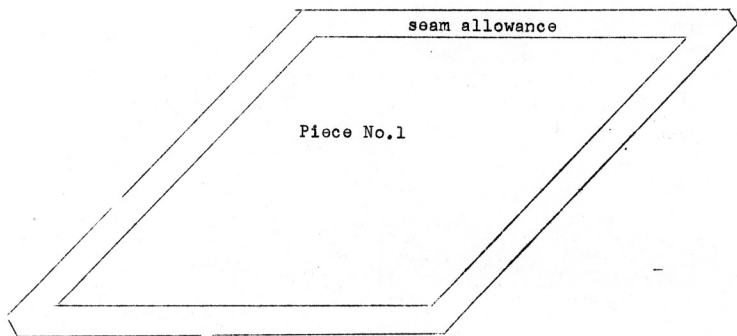
Quilt along all the seams of the piecing. Continue the diagonal lines into the squares and plain daiamonds as shown in illustration.

Cut 288 small diamonds(Piece No.1). Cut 4 large squares(Piece No.2) for corners. Cut 4 large triangles (Piece No.3) for center of sides. Piece No.4 is to be used as a GUIDE for making large diamonds which form the points of the star. This large diamond is made of 36 small diamonds (Piece No.1). DO NOT CUT ANY MATERIAL FOR PIECE NO.4. NO ALLOWANCE is made for seams in Piece 2 and 3. You must allow for these yourself, when cutting. Be sure to measure accurately the side of the completed large pieced diamonds.

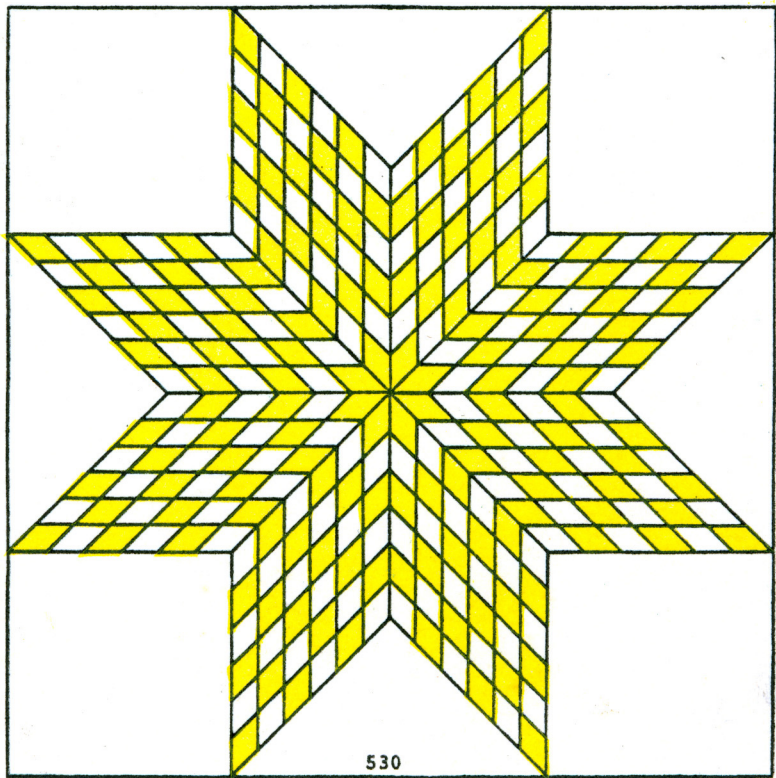

DIRECTIONS FOR LONE STAR PATTERN No. 530.

Cut 288 small diamonds (piece No. 1). If two or more colors are used, divide this number into the required amount for each color. Cut 4 large squares (piece No. 2) for corners. Cut 4 large triangles (piece No. 3). Piece No. 4 is to be used as a guide for making the large diamonds, which form the points of the star. This large diamond is made of 36 small diamonds (piece No. 1). Do not cut any material for No. 4. No allowance is made for seams on this pattern. You must allow for these yourself, when cutting the material.
