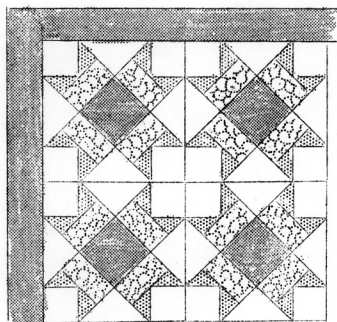


QUILT PATTERN NO.158-CENTENNIAL



Corner of Completed Quilt

SIZE OF QUILT--84x97 inches
 This quilt is made up of forty-two 13-inch pieced blocks set six blocks in width and seven in length with a 3-inch plain border strip.

COLORS

We suggest white, lavender, pink and a harmonizing print. Any three colors may be substituted.

AMOUNT OF MATERIAL REQUIRED

White.....4 yards
 Lavender.....3 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards
 Pink.....2 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards
 Print.....2 $\frac{1}{4}$ yards

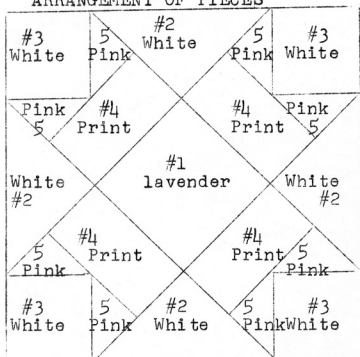
NUMBER OF PIECES TO BE CUT

Piece No.1.....42 lavender
 " No.2.....168 white
 " No.3.....168 white
 " No.4.....168 print
 " No.5.....336 pink

2 strips, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ x8 $\frac{1}{4}$ in.--lavender
 2 " , 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ x9 $\frac{7}{8}$ in.--lavender

NOTE: Cut strips first to get full length without piecing.

ARRANGEMENT OF PIECES



The numeral are the piece numbers.

SUGGESTIONS FOR CUTTING

Trace pieces of the pattern on light cardboard or sandpaper and cut out. Use these cardboard or sandpaper patterns as cutting guides. The most accurate method is to lay the cardboard or sandpaper pattern on the material (rough side down if sandpaper is used); mark around the pattern with pencil. Cut out on pencil lines. Whenever possible, lay all straight edges of the pattern parallel with the threads of the material.

QUILTING

Quilt along all seams of the piecing. Use our quilting design No. Q42(2-inch width) on plain border strip.
