Colors are unbleached & pink print.

4. "World's Fair" pieced in 1930  
Quilted by Mother. 1938  
This is a News pattern  
Colors are plain lavender & pink print.

5. "Dresden Plate". made in 1930.  
Quilted by Mother. 1937.  
Sections of plate are pieced together  
and then applique on unbleached.  
Centers of plates are peach.

6. "Trip Around World", pieced in 6 wks. 1932.  
Quilted by Church ladies in 1933.  
We first saw this quilt ~~saw~~ at  
a display in Hudson's - June 1932. We  
took notes on size of block - number 4

Combination of colors. The exact measurements for colors and materials were worked out at home that evening.

Peach prints were bought in Lansing.  
Others were bought in Detroit.

7. "Iris Quilt". made in 1933.  
Quilted by Mother 1935  
This is applique in colors on an ivory background & is a M.T. Mist pattern. Made of "Peter Pan" and paid for with Detroit scrip.

8. "New Flower Garden". applique.  
Made by Mother 1933  
Quilted " 1934.  
All baskets are lavender as well as border.

9. "Flower Garden". Crayon work.

All flowers are colored with wax crayons - then pressed with hot iron.

small prints (hexagon) pieced together  
with plain green & unbleached.

Made by Mother - 1934.

Multi-color pieces (no 2 alike) put  
together with light green background.

12. "Rose Wreath" - Ann Orr pattern.  
Resembles cross-stitched wreaths.  
Pieced by Mother - 1935-6  
Quilted " " 1936-7.  
Won Honorable Mention Ribbon at New  
Quilt Show - May 1937.

13. "Antique Urn". Applique.  
Shared cost of pattern (3.50) with  
5 other quilters (Mrs. Voelker).  
Made in 1935 - 6.  
Quilted by Mother in Fall 1939.  
Quilting took 156 hours.  
Won Honorable Mention Ribbon at  
News Quilt Show - May 1940.
