

Four Set Blocks

SIZE OF QUILT, 78x96 inches

This quilt is made up of eighty 9-inch pieced blocks set eight in width and ten in length with a 3-inch plain border. In arranging blocks, you may arrange rows from left to right with the center "V" pointing down; then the next row "V" pointing up etc.. Or, you may arrange all rows with the "V" pointing down or up.

AMOUNT OF MATERIAL
White
Blue 3 yards
Light greenl2 yards
Pink5½ yards

COLORS

We suggest white, light green and pink. Any harmonizing color arrangement may be used.

NUMBER OF PIECES TO BE CUT
Piece No.1.....160 pink
"No.2.....160 white
"No.2....160 light green
"No.3.....80 light green
"No.3.....80 white
"No.3.....320 blue
2 strips, 3\frac{1}{2}x78\frac{1}{2} inches....pink
2 ,3\frac{1}{2}x96\frac{1}{2} inches....pink
1 NOTE: Cut strips first to get full length without piecing.


SUGGESTIONS FOR CUTTING
Trace pieces of the pattern on light
cardboard or sandpaper and cut out.
Use these cardboard or sandpaper
pieces as cutting guides. The most
accurate method is to lay cardboard
or sandpaper pieces(rough side down)
on the material and draw the outline
with pencil. Cut out on pencil lines.
Whenever possible lay straight edges
of the pattern parallel with the
threads of the material.

QUILTING Quilt along all seams of the piecing. Use our quilting design No. Q43(2-inch width) on the plain strip.
