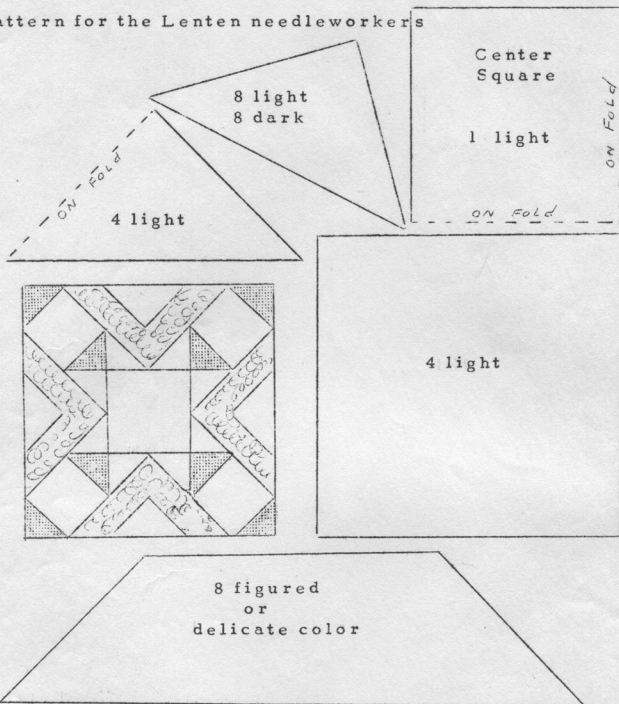


# ST. GREGORY'S CROSS

A pattern for the Lenten needleworkers



This old pattern of St. Gregory's Cross is one that women often made during Lent. It may be made in the red & purples of ecclesiastical shades. A delicate shade may be substituted for the figured strip. If cardinal red is used for the points, a dusty shade of pink is used for the strip; if purple is used, a delicate lavender; or pale yellow with orange
