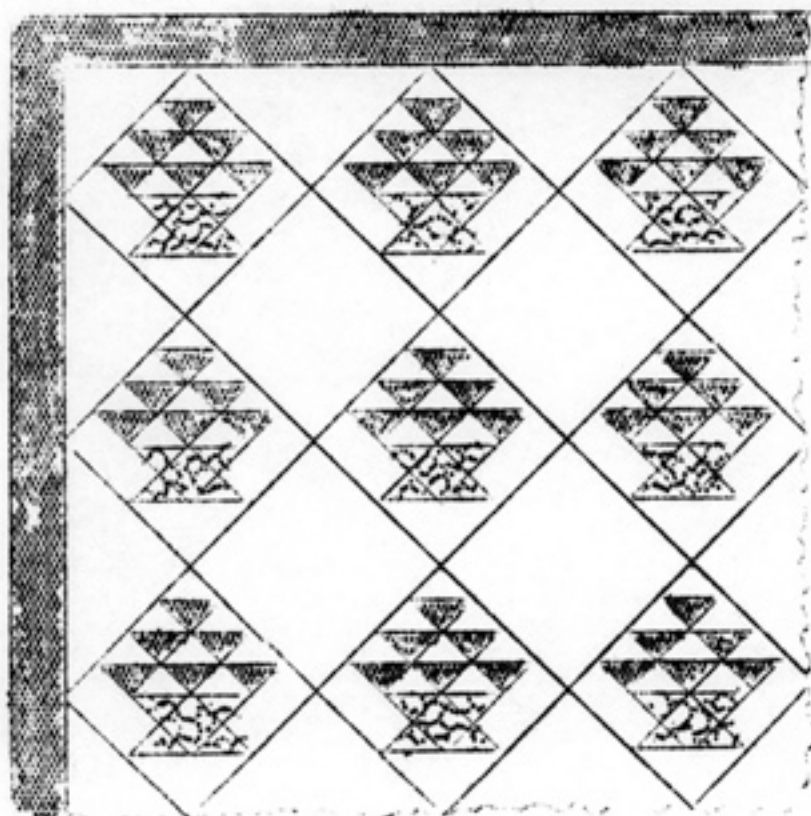


QUILT PATTERN NO.57--FLOWER BASKET



Corner of Completed Quilt

SIZE OF QUILT, 81x93 inches.

This quilt is made up of forty-two 9-inch pieced blocks, four $\frac{1}{4}$ plain blocks, twenty-two $\frac{1}{2}$ plain blocks, set six blocks in width and seven in length with a 3-inch plain border. The blocks are set diagonally.

COLORS

White, a print material and a solid color to harmonize are suggested. See Color Chart for arrangement.

AMOUNT OF MATERIAL

White.....7 yards and 12 inches
 Print.....1 " and 12 inches
 Solid color...3 "
 Total.....11 $\frac{2}{3}$ yards.

Lining, 90-inch width, white,
 2 and $\frac{2}{3}$ yards.

NUMBER OF PIECES TO BE CUT

- Piece No.1.....42 white
- " No.1.....42 print
- " No.2.....84 print
- " No.2.....252 solid color
- " No.2.....336 white
- " No.3.....84 white
- 30 squares $9\frac{1}{2} \times 9\frac{1}{2}$ inches, white
- 11 " 10x10 " " (cut in half diagonally to be used
 on side and top and bottom of quilt)
- 2 squares 7x7 inches, white(cut in half diagonally twice to be used
 at each of the four corners of quilt)
- 2 strips, $3\frac{1}{2} \times 81\frac{1}{2}$ inches.....solid color
- 2 " , $3\frac{1}{2} \times 93\frac{1}{2}$ inches.....solid color

NOTE: Cut strips first to get full length without piecing.

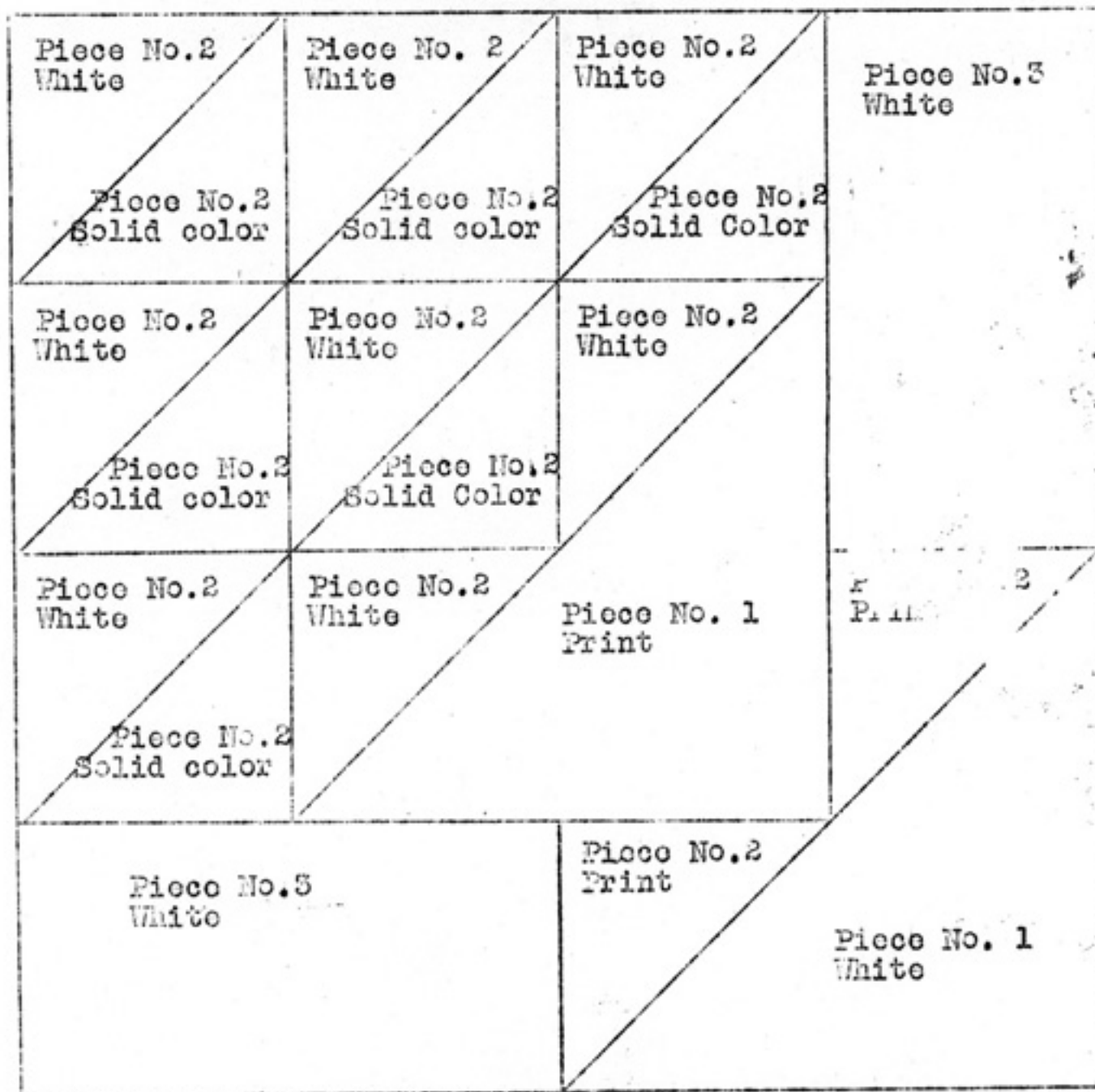
SUGGESTIONS FOR CUTTING

Trace pieces of the pattern on light cardboard or sandpaper and cut out. Use these cardboard or sandpaper pieces as cutting guides. The most accurate method is to lay cardboard or sandpaper patterns on the material and mark around with pencil. Cut out on pencil lines. Whenever possible lay straight edges of the pattern parallel with the threads of the material.

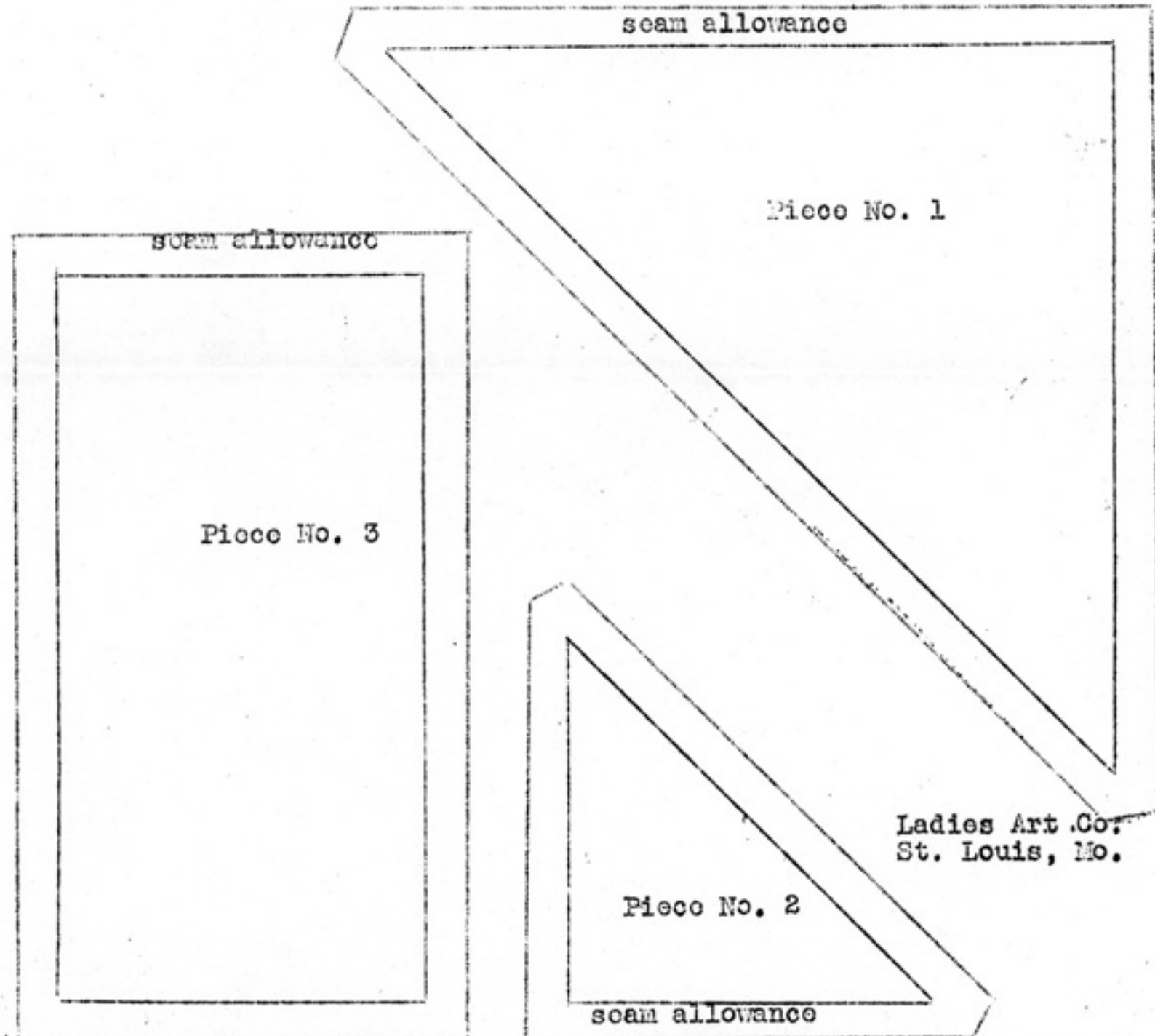
QUILTING

Quilt along all seams of the piecing. Use our quilting design No. Q80 in plain squares. Use our border quilting design No.Q43(2-inch) on plain border strip.

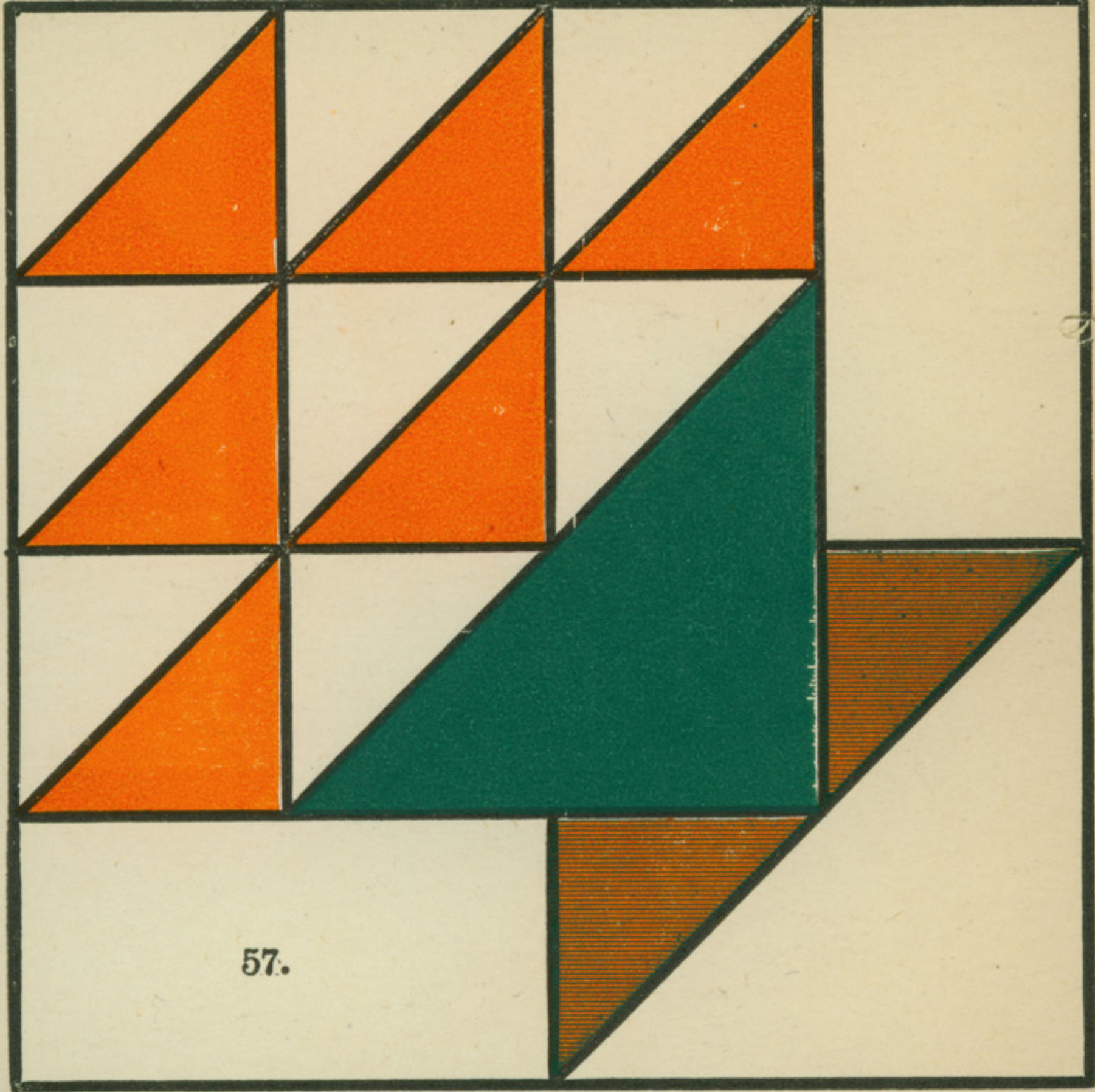
QUILT PATTERN NO. 57--FLOWER BASKET
