
QUILT NO. 58-CHERRY BASKET SIZE OF QUILT 84x96-INCHES

INSTRUCTION SHEET QUILT PATTERN NO. 58-CHERRY BASKET

SIMBOF QUILT, when completed, 84x96-inches.

This quilt as shown on other side of this sheet is made up of forty two 12-inch pieced blocks, with two-tone 6-inch strips forming panels in center of quilt. A distinctive touch may be given to this quilt by outlining or quilting a bowknot around the handles of the basket. (See pattern sheet.)

COLORS

Two shades of yellow for baskets and a white background, and two shades of yellow for the strips are suggested for this quilt.

AMOUNT OF MATERIAL

Lining, white, 90-inch w idth (not included above) ----- 2 2/3 yards.

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SUGGESTIONS FOR QUILTING AND SEVENG

Quilt along seams of piecing. Use our quilting design No. Q44-2inch width for panel strips. Quilt open spaces on blocks with triangles to correspond with triangles in basket. Thebow-knot design for basket handle shown on pattern sheet may be quilted or worked in out line stitch in green, or other harmonizing color. Piece, No.5, basket handle is appliqued on to piece No.1. (See pattern sheet.)

SUGGESTIONS FOR CUTTING

Trace pieces of the pattern on light cardboard or sandpaper and cut out. Use these cardboard or sandpaper pieces as cutting guides. The most accurate method is to lay cardboard or sandpaper (rough side down) on the material. Cut all straight pieces straight with the edge of material.
