

Four set blocks


SIZE OF QUILT, 80x99 inches.
This quilt is made up of twenty
15-inch pieced blocks set four
in width and five in length with
4-inch plain strips between the
blocks and a 4-inch plain border.

COLORS

We suggest white, yellow and a print for this quilt. Any color may be substituted or two colors. See Color Chart for arrangement of colors.

AMOUNT OF MATERIAL REQUIRED
White....4 yards
Print....1 yard and 27 inches.
Yellow....5 yards " 9
Above does not include lining.
Total material above...ll yards.
Lining...81-inch width, 2 yards
and27 inches...white.

QUILTING threads of mat Quilt along all seams of the piecing.
Use our Q45(3-inch size) for border and strips.

Piece No.1...80 print

" No.1...20 white

" No.2..220 white

" No.3...160 yellow

" No.3...80 white

" No.4...60 white

31 strips, 4\frac{1}{2}x15\frac{1}{2} in.


12 squares, 4\frac{1}{2}x4\frac{1}{2} in.

2 strips, 4\frac{1}{2}x80\frac{1}{2} in.

2 strips, 4\frac{1}{2}x99\frac{1}{2} in.

Strips and squares are yellow.

SUGGESTIONS FOR CUTTING Trace pieces of the pattern on light cardboard or sandpaper and cut out. Use these cardboard or sandpaper patterns as cutting guides. The most accurate method is to lay cardboard or sandpaper pattern on the material and mark around Cut out with pencil. on pencil lines. Lay straight edges of the pattern parallel with threads of material.
