# "BROKEN STAR"

Pattern No. 110 of the Mountain Mist Series

(A Pieced Quilt)

Stars are always the most popular design with women who piece quilts. No State Fair Quilt Display is complete without many variations of the design. Among the most often seen is the Broken Star which we give you as the newest pattern in our series. We hope that you will enjoy making this lovely arrangement.

## DIRECTIONS:-

1. Make actual size Pattern for all Parts as numbered. To do this, trace the outlines through thin paper, paste onto cardboard or the smooth side of sandpaper, and cut out exactly along the pencilled lines. Or transfer directly with carbon paper. Sandpaper patterns placed rough side down on the goods will not slip in marking. Mark Part number on each pattern. We suggest that you make several patterns for Part No. 1 since there are so many pieces to be marked one pattern may become worn and inaccurate.

2. If there is any doubt about the fastness of the colors, or if there is a possibility of shrinkage, first wash and iron the materials to be used. If the material for the top is washed before making the quilt be sure to wash and iron the material for the back.

3. Mark the required number of Parts on each color as listed in Yardage Chart. Mark on the wrong side of the material so that the pencilled lines will remain to follow in piecing. Space the outlines far enough apart to allow for seams ( $\frac{1}{4}$ " or less) when the pieces are cut. DO NOT CUT ALONG THESE LINES but allow for seams outside of them.

4. From the white material cut two strips for end panels  $64"$  x  $8"$ . From colored materials cut the outside border strips as shown in Yardage Chart. Next cut twenty  $8"$  squares and 8 half squares for insets in Star and Corners of central part of quilt. From remaining material cut diamonds for Star as indicated on Yardage Chart. Arrange in color groups and fasten with a single stitch so that each part will be ready for use.

5. Following the Diagram of the Diamond which forms the point of the Stars, piece the parts together. You will need 32 of these pieced Diamonds.

6. You are now ready to assemble the Broken Star. One of the most important steps in making this quilt is accuracy in marking and following the markings in piecing. The least variation will cause a pucker in putting the Star together. We suggest that each Diamond be carefully pressed before you piece them together. If there should be a slight pucker at the center you will find that it will be flattened by the quilting. First join 8 pieced Diamonds to form the Central Star. To this add the Squares as shown in the diagram of the quilt.

7. To add the outer ring of the Broken Star we suggest that you join the pieced Diamonds in groups of three to fit into the Angles at the points of the Center Star. There will be eight groups of three. When this is complete finish the entire Broken Star by adding these groups to the plain squares—See Diagram of the Quilt. Complete the squares at each corner and two half squares at each side. Complete the quilt with the end panels and outer borders. You are now ready for the quilting.

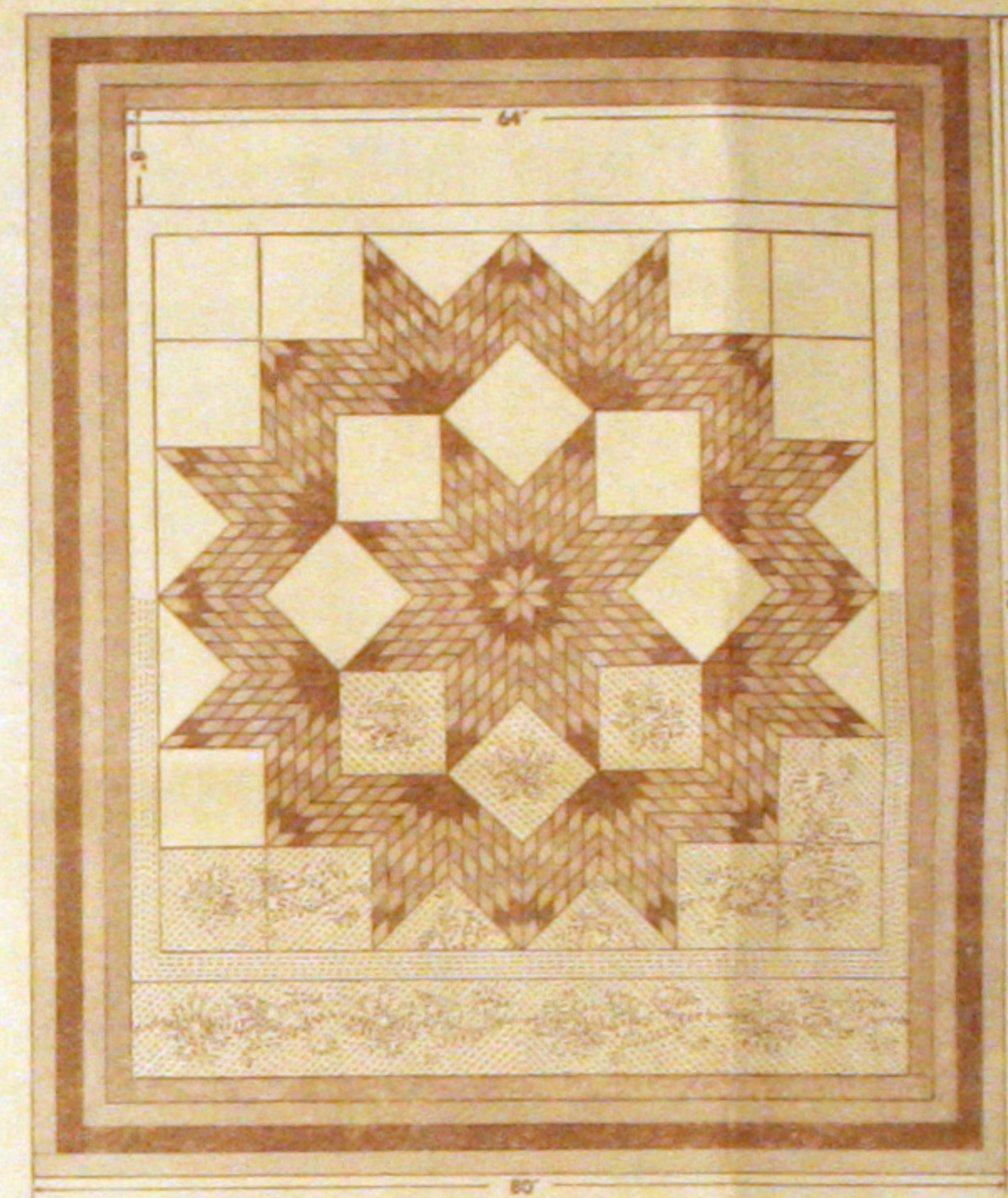
## QUILTING SUGGESTIONS

We have given you a new and original design for this quilt. The design is given in  $\frac{1}{4}$  the length which may be duplicated across the end panels. The flower is placed in the plain blocks. The design may be traced in the proper spaces. See Diagram of Quilt. The background may be ruled by using a yard stick and a well sharpened soft pencil. Do not mark too heavily. The pencil lines may be removed with a soft eraser when the quilting is completed.

A perforated marking pattern may be made by tracing the quilting design on heavy paper. Then perforate by following the lines with an unthreaded sewing machine needle using a large stitch. Remove the perforated bits of paper with sandpaper.

When the quilting is complete, remove from the frame and finish the edges with a narrow bias strip of either plain white or a color you choose from the star.

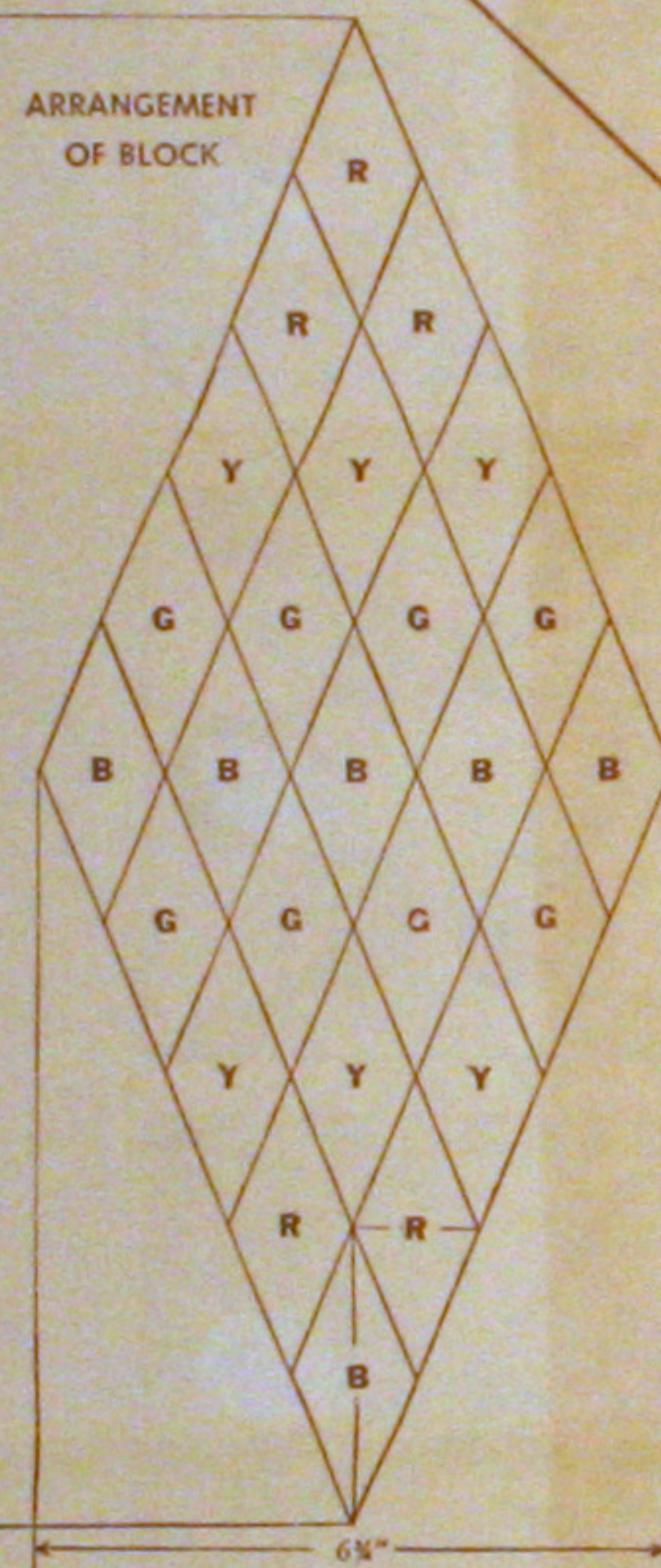
