# "QUILTED COUNTERPANE" of the MOUNTAIN MIST Series AN ALL-QUILTED QUILT

PATTERN NO. 111

of the MOUNTAIN MIST Series

Many women who enjoy quilting have asked for a pattern which could be used for making an all-over quilted Counterpane. For this reason we have combined seven of our perforated Quilting Designs to make this type of quilt, and have given you these patterns in actual size for use in marking it.

### DIRECTIONS

First make marking patterns by tracing the quilting designs on

a light weight cardboard or heavy paper. You will note that the circles of the design are only given in one half of the complete circle. When making your marking patterns for these circles complete them by drawing the two halves matching at the center.

Next perforate the marking patterns by following the lines with an unthreaded sewing machine needle, using a large stitch. Remove the excess paper from the perforations on the back by rubbing with a piece of sandpaper. You are now ready to mark your quilt top.

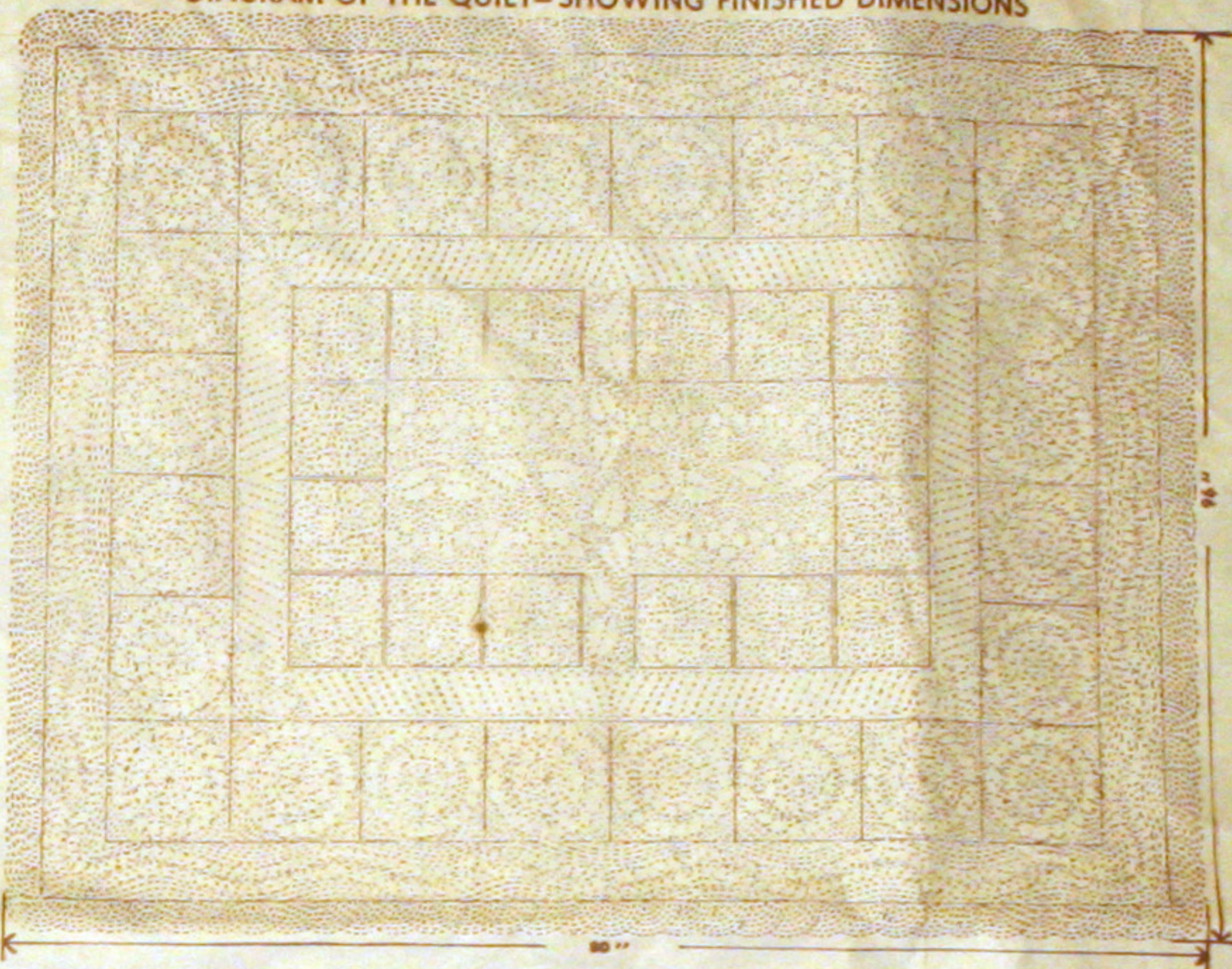
First join two pieces of material 36" wide and 96 1/2" wide. Add to this a strip 9 1/2" wide and 96 1/2" long to make the top 80" wide by 96 1/2" long. This allows for 1/2" seam on each side of the top. The same sheet 80 1/2" by 96 1/2" will be needed for the backing. The seams will be absorbed in the quilting.

Following the Diagram of the finished quilt, rule straight lines for the outlines of the different quilting patterns. Use a yard rule with a well sharpened pencil. Place the quilting patterns within these outlines and mark by rubbing colored chalk over the perforations. Remove the pattern and strengthen the marking with a soft pencil. Next fill in the background with straight lines as shown in the Diagram. These background lines should be no more than 1/8" apart. For a finer looking counterpane we suggest 1/16" space between these lines. The closer the background lines the more your quilting designs will be emphasized.

Mark the entire quilt before starting the quilting so that you will be assured of the accuracy of your design. If the markings become indistinct they may be strengthened with pencil as the quilting progresses.

To Quilt your Counterpane place the backing on your frame, lay on the Mountain Mist Cotton, and cover with the marked top. Fasten securely into your frame and you are ready for the actual quilting. Following the lines of the marked design, quilt with a fine running stitch. A good Professional Quilter will stitch as many as 14 stitches to an inch.

No matter how finely you quilt the evenness of the stitches is of great importance.

When the entire top is finished, remove from the frame and bind the edges with bias strips.

If you prefer to quilt with a hoop, be sure to baste the back, the Mountain Mist Cotton

and the marked top very closely before placing in the hoop. This will avoid puckering.

When the quilt is completed you will find that you have a lovely spread for your bed which is as beautiful on one side as on the other.
