# PIN WHEEL

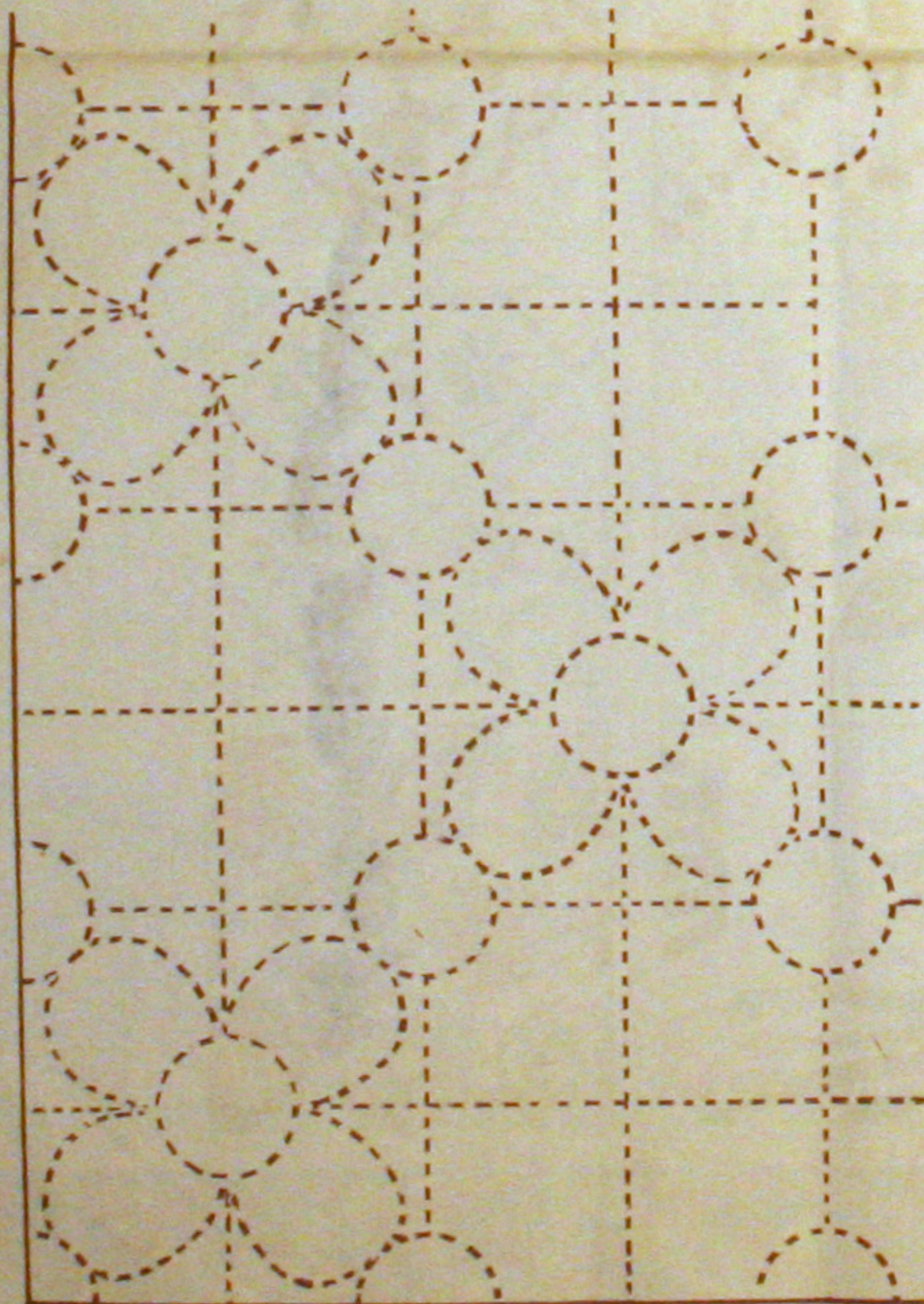
Pattern No. 125 of the Mountain Mist Series  
(A Pieced Quilt)

Stars have always been among the favorite designs for pieced quilts. This four pointed star is beautiful in its simplicity. For those who like a star quilt, the Pin Wheel is an easy quilt to make. Its inner border of fancy quilting makes it an unusual quilt with an antique quality.

## DIRECTIONS

1. First make a marking pattern for each Part. To do this, first trace the actual size patterns with this paper. Paste onto thin cardboard or the smooth side of a fine sandpaper. Sandpaper patterns are less apt to slip while marking when placed rough side down on the material. Cut out the pattern exactly on the outlines and mark the Part number with the number of pieces to be cut from each color on it. Since there are so many pieces to be marked, we suggest that you make at least 2 Part 1 patterns. In doing a lot of marking one pattern may become worn and inaccurate.
2. If there is any danger of shrinkage or fading, wash and iron your materials before marking. If you wash and iron the materials for your quilt top, be sure to wash and iron the material for the backing.
3. Before marking the pieces from the white material, measure and cut the strips for the inner borders. Be sure to allow at least  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seams on all sides of these strips and remove the selvege edges before you measure. From the remaining material mark and cut the required number of Part 2 pieces.

## QUILTING SUGGESTIONS



4. Mark your pieces on the back of the material. Allow for at least  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seams around each piece and mark exactly around the pattern. Do not pull the material while marking. Do not mark too heavily. Heavy markings penetrate the material and make the markings difficult to remove. DO NOT CUT ALONG THESE LINES. They will be a guide for joining the pieces. Assemble your pieces in color groups and fasten together with a loose stitch so that they will not be lost and will be ready for use when you need them.
5. You will need 212 of the pieced blocks. Eighty-eight will form the central panel of the top. The border is thirty-two blocks wide - 2 deep and 16 across. Each side border requires 30 blocks between the end borders - 2 deep and 15 long.
6. Piece all of the blocks required. We suggest that you join the four points of the star with the prints and plain pieces on opposite points. Add four Part 2 pieces to complete the block. Join 88 blocks for the center panel with the print points meeting in straight lines from top to bottom. Join the required blocks for the border and you are ready to assemble your quilt top.
7. First add the side inner border strips - 55" x 10" - to the long side of the central panel. To this add the end inner borders - 75" x 10". Add the outer borders in the same manner - first the side borders and finally the end borders to complete the entire top.

## QUILTING SUGGESTIONS

You will note that the joining of your blocks forms an eight-sided white piece between the stars. We suggest that you quilt the central panel and borders as shown on the diagram. This will produce a quilted Pin Wheel in the white Octagon which is the same as the pieced star.

We have given you a quilting design for the inner border of plain white. This is drawn on this pattern and is also among the patterns on Sheet C of our perforated quilting designs. The background for the fancier design is straight lines drawn through the centers of the flowers and the circle which joins them.

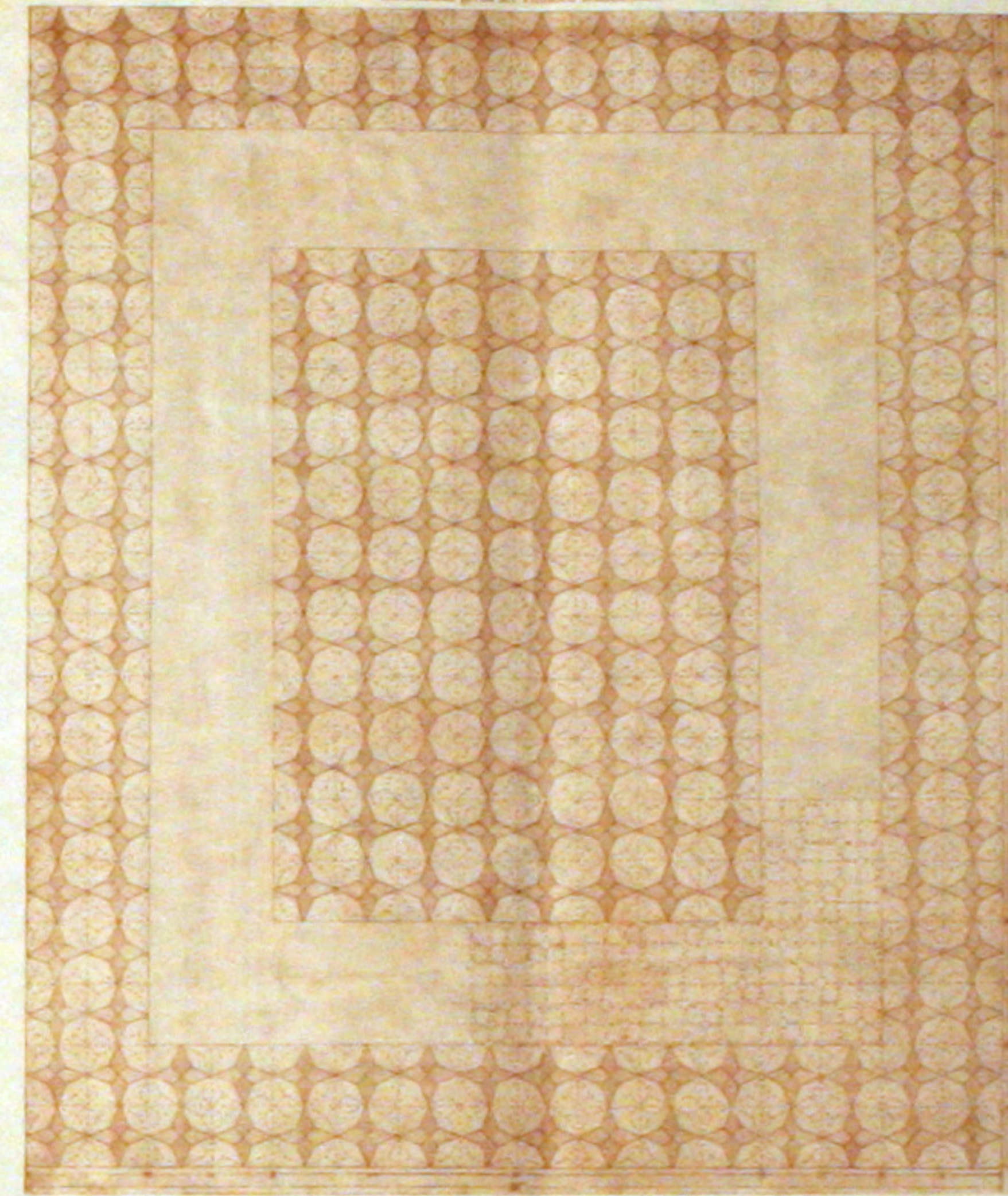
