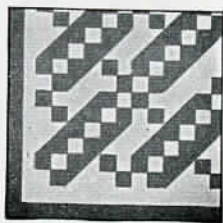

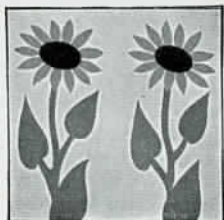
- A—TUMBLING BLOCKS. Also an arrangement included for Disappearing Blocks. A pieced quilt with 18-inch block.
- B—GUIDE POST. Pieced quilt with 15 1/2-inch block.
- D—ZIG ZAG. Pieced quilt, 17-inch block.
- F—LONE STAR. Picture much reduced; one large star makes the whole quilt. Pieced.
- G—CHANTICLEER. Child's quilt, applique. Pattern includes arrangements for two quilts; also designs for hen and chicks. 15-inch block.
- H—TREE OF PARADISE. Pieced quilt, 17 1/2-inch block.
- J—WINDBLOWN TULIP. 17 1/2-inch block, applique. Tulip border.
- K—BASKET OF FLOWERS. 17 1/2-inch block, piecework and applique. Triangle border.
- L—HARRISON ROSE. 17 1/2-inch block, applique. Scalloped border.
- M—CONVENTIONAL TULIP. 17 1/2-inch block, applique, with running vine border.

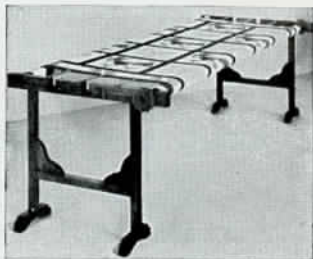

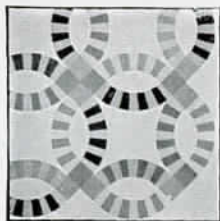
- N—MOUNTAIN STAR. Applique, with inter-block border. 22-inch block.
- O—JACOB'S LADDER. Pieced quilt, 15-inch block.
- P—SUNFLOWER. Applique, with irregular block; Block pictured, 22 inches.
- R—IRIS. Applique, with inter-block border. Irregular blocks, about 19 inches deep.
- S—PRINCESS FEATHER. Applique, with $33\frac{3}{4}$ -inch block. Inter-block border.
- T—ACORN AND OAK LEAF. Applique, with $17\frac{1}{2}$ -inch block.
- X—NEW YORK BEAUTY. Pieced quilt, $21\frac{1}{2}$ -inch block.
- 20—OHIO ROSE. Applique, with running vine border. $17\frac{1}{2}$ -inch block.
- 21—DOUBLE WEDDING RING. Pieced. Diameter of ring about 20 inches.
- 22—OLD-FASHIONED ROSE. Applique. 17-inch block, placed diagonally on quilt.
- 23—TURKEY TRACKS. Pieced quilt, 8-inch block. Set together with alternate white blocks, quilted.



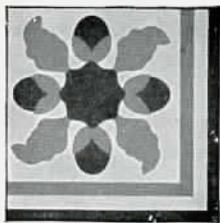

HOW TO ORDER PATTERNS

When you purchase a roll of Mountain Mist Quilting Cotton, you will find a Quilt Pattern Coupon printed on the inside of the wrapper; also printed inside the wrapper is a full size working pattern. No choice of design is offered for this sample pattern, but the Pattern Coupon, with only 20¢, entitles you to send for your choice of any other one of the Mountain Mist Patterns. The price of the patterns is 35¢ each when a coupon does not accompany the order for each pattern. In other words, the price of one pattern, when coupon accompanies order — 20¢; price of more than one pattern, with only one coupon — 20¢ first pattern, and 35¢ each additional pattern.

EACH PATTERN COMPLETE

Mountain Mist Quilt Patterns are printed on heavy bond paper, so that the designs can be traced or pasted directly onto cardboard. Each figure is shown in actual size; and the appliqued figures are shown in exactly the positions they should have on the blocks, so that placing your designs is a simple matter. Clear, complete directions come with each pattern, telling how many yards of cloth to purchase from your store, and how many parts of each color to cut; also how to piece, or to applique, the design, and how to attach the border. There is even a diagram of the finished quilt, with border arrangement and dimensions. A suggestion for the most appropriate quilting design is also given, and, where necessary, a sketch or a full-size diagram to guide you.

THEIR LASTING CHARM is the chief beauty of quilts made from Mountain Mist Patterns. You can be sure that the time spent is well worth while, for in making a Mountain Mist quilt, you are following either the best of the "antique" patterns, or the most attractive of modern additions to the quilt-making art. Patterns for reproducing treasured heirlooms, original designs to bring new interest to your collection — all are available in the Mountain Mist Series. And new ones are regularly added.

MOUNTAIN MIST QUILTING COTTON—
The Perfect Filling For Quilts, is preferred by experienced quilters because it is so convenient and handy to use. A quilt filled with Mountain Mist may be quilted easily with the most elaborate designs, and will launder beautifully.

Mountain Mist Quilting Cotton comes to you in a roll weighing about one pound; the pure white cotton is in one single sheet, 72 by 90 inches (2 yards by 2½ yards). It is covered on both sides with "Glazene," which is of very soft, lace-like texture, permitting easy handling and making possible the nice, even thickness so important for satisfactory quilting.

Mountain Mist is made only from clean, new cotton, thoroughly washed in filtered artesian well water to give it a bright whiteness that will enhance the colors in your quilt top. Cotton that is even slightly yellow deadens quilt top colors.

Ask for Mountain Mist Quilting Cotton by name—insist upon the genuine in the quilt-block wrapper, printed in full colors. It comes under no other name. Quilters will avoid sore and needle-punctured fingers by refusing to use substitutes which are made like ordinary wadding, with surfaces unsuited for the needle.

Over 85 years experience in the manufacture of both cotton wadding and cotton batting have contributed to the perfection of Mountain Mist Quilting Cotton. Mountain Mist is made by the manufacturers of "White Rose" Cotton Batting, used in many of the quilts that are antiques today.
