Since 1998 the American Quilt Study Group Research Library has been cataloged, housed and preserved by the University of Nebraska-Lincoln Libraries. The library supports AQSG membership throughout the world. In addition, the AQSG Research Library complements research and study activities at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln, including the International Quilt Study Center & Museum also located on the University campus.

The general collection of the AQSG Research Library contains more than 4000 books, journals, and other quilt-related materials.

Sally Garoutte's library (founder of the American Quilt Study Group www.americanquiltstudygroup.org), AQSG archival records, and selected papers and records of quilt historians, quilt makers, and quilt guilds and associations are located in the Libraries' Archives & Special Collections. To locate all the titles in the AQSG Research Library, do a keyword search under "American Quilt Study Group". Should you desire to read a book or journal article in this collection, first check to see if it is available at your local library. If not, most likely the librarians would be willing to submit an interlibrary loan request to the University of Nebraska-Lincoln Libraries or another library. While most quilt-related materials in the Libraries' general collection can be requested, items in Archives & Special Collections are usually not available through interlibrary loan.
