

with fluted ruffles, put up with a valance of the same material trimmed with two fluted ruffles and caught back with ruffled bands.

The furniture might be of walnut and the spread of jade green moire made in very tailored fashion, the seams being piped in apricot satin.

For the slip covers or furniture covering there might be flowered chintz with a lavender background, the seams being piped in jade green.

There might be over-draperies in this room of flowered chintz with a jade green background and even though there were flowered wall

paper, and the furniture may be finished in red trimmed with black.

With the first scheme there might be light yellow oil-cloth for the covering of the cupboard shelves and the edges might be finished with green and white embossed paper trimming. With the second scheme, there might be light green oil-cloth for the covering of the shelves, the edges being finished with red and white embossed paper trimming.
