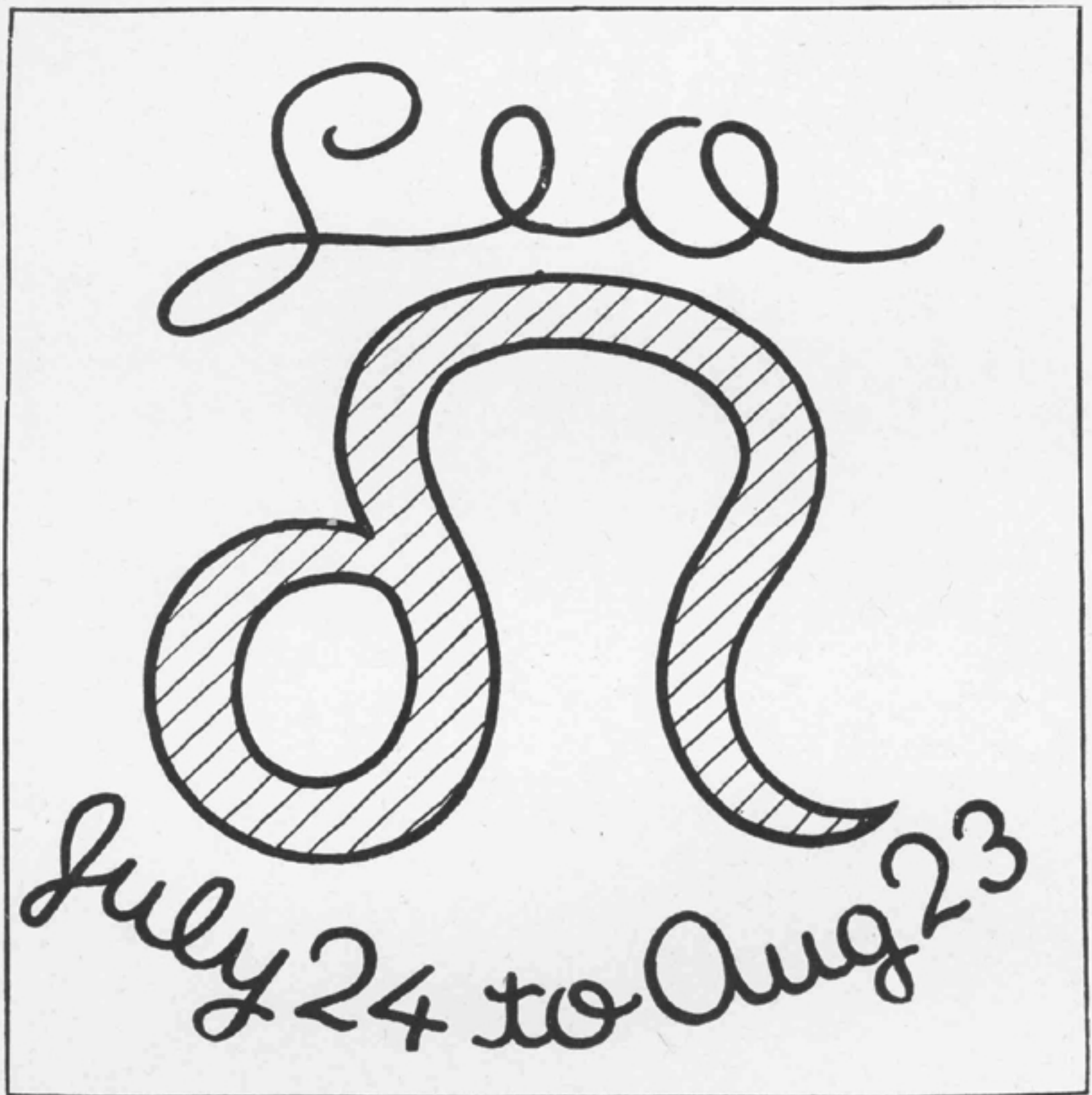

IT may seem odd that the fifth zodiac sign, which is shown on this week's leaflet, does not represent the fifth or month of May. But, as has been explained in one of the first leaflets, the idea is taken from an old almanac. This showed a human figure with dotted lines leading from various parts of the figure to the various zodiac signs.

Naturally the start is made at the

head and since that sign is Aries which the ancients believed ruled the sky in the month—as we now know it—of April, the beginning is made there. That makes April come first; May, second; June, third; July fourth and August fifth.
