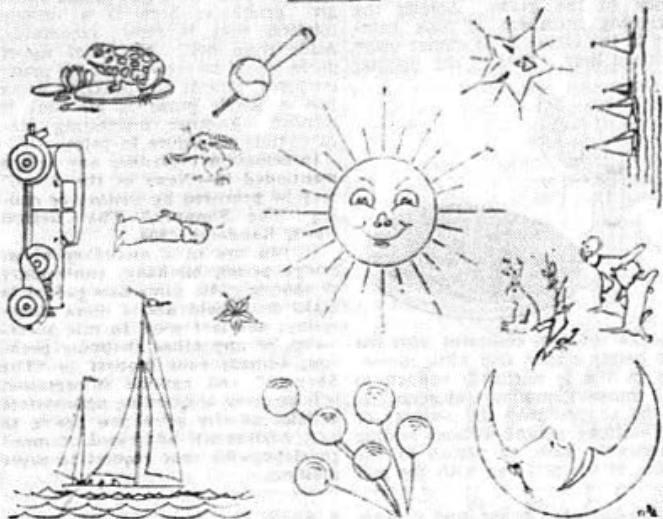


BEAUTY IN THE HOME.

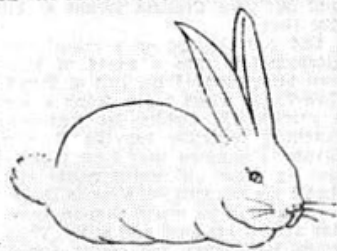


THERE isn't a design in the large illustration that would not be a joy to a little boy, for balloons, automobiles, sailing ships, base balls and bats all seem to be fascinating to children. The bunnies, Scotties, chirping bird, smiling sun and star, as well as the friendly moon, are also attractive motifs that would be a delight to a child. Little girls will enjoy them as well as the little boys.

They may be used for painted decorations, for the outlines are so simple that they are easy to fill in or they may be used for embroidery, the etching or chain-stitch lending itself to the plain outlines.

Every child likes to have a painting book and it is really more fun to make one than to buy it already finished. The transferring is so easy to do—for all that is necessary is to dampen the back of the design after it has been laid, face down, on the material to which it is to be

applied and then rub over it with the bowl of a spoon or other smooth object.

Baked Short Ribs of Beef.

Five pounds short ribs of beef, 5 medium sized potatoes, 2 large onions, 1 small rutabaga, 4 medium sized carrots, 3 teaspoons salt, 1/2 teaspoon pepper. Wipe the meat with a damp cloth, rub with salt and pepper, place in roaster and sear for 30 minutes in a hot oven, 550 degrees Fahrenheit. Reduce temperature to 325 degrees Fahrenheit or moderate oven. Add two cups water, cover closely and bake one hour, then add whole potatoes, pared, carrots cut in halves, onion and rutabaga, quartered. Bake for two hours. Serve meat on platter garnished with vegetables. Serves five to six.

Pear Salad.

Pear halves, cream cheese, lettuce, whole cloves, mayonnaise, paprika. Press the two halves of pears together with cream cheese and stand upright on lettuce cup. Insert clove at top for stem. Top with mayonnaise or French dressing as preferred and dust lightly on sides with paprika.
