

Edith Crumb JAN 8 1970 dies; home decor editor

Edith B. Crumb, Detroit News home furnishings editor for many years before her retirement in 1958, died today in her apartment in Dearborn.

Miss Crumb, 76, was a nationally known authority on interior decoration, especially in the field of American antiques.

She planned The News' books of model home designs, and a number of her original plans are still used in the current issue, "92 Home Designs."

A native of Buffalo, N.Y., Miss Crumb was employed at The News almost 34 years. She leaves no immediate survivors.
