Fried Canned Tomatoes

Drain contents of 1 can whole tomatoes, and save juice for cocktails or sauce. Roll tomatoes in coarse, well seasoned bread crumbs; set aside about 1 hour to dry. Saute tomatoes in small amount of hot butter until browned. Place on slices of hot


