

Here is the method of laying out the blocks of this quilt. While this shows a straight edge, it would be attractive if finished with a large scallop, reaching from block to block, this being bound in a color to match the predominating one in the wreath.

The border can be straight or scalloped. The floral pattern is run in a straight line through the middle of the border strip. The pattern should be arranged on the border so that a large flower is placed opposite blocks together.


