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### *Quilt Exhibit at the Art Institute*

For the first time since 1965, the famous quilt collection of The Art Institute of Chicago will be on exhibit this fall at the Museum. Because of limited space the exhibit will be in two parts. The first segment is on display now and includes quilts made by Dr. Jeannette Dean Throckmorton and Bertha Stenge. The second part will be on display on November 9 through January 21, 1979.

There is no catalog for the present show and the one from the last show in 1965, entitled AMERICAN QUILTS, is out of print.

Christa C. M. Thurman, Curator of Textiles at the Institute, organized the exhibition. There are approximately fifty quilts in the permanent collection dating from 1795 to 1950.

Quilters may want to arrange their visit for November 6th and stay in Chicago until November 9th in order to see the entire collection.
