
From your Editor

MARY SCHAFER IS HONORED

On Friday evening, Sept 12 the Birmingham Bloomfield Art Association held a preview party of a quilt exhibit entitled "Then & Now" in honor of Mary Schafer, well known prize-winning quiltmaker and collector. It was a fitting tribute to a lovely lady who has done so much for quilting. The exhibition includes 13 traditional quilts from Mrs Schafer's 200+ collection and 13 contemporary interpretations designed and made especially by Gwen Marston & Joe Cunningham, master quiltmakers from Beaver Island, MI for the show's "Now" portion. The show will travel to Michigan museums and art galleries.

The State of Michigan honored Mrs Schafer with a Senate Resolution: "Resolved by the Senate that we proudly commend Mary Schafer for her many contributions to the art of quiltmaking as she is honored through a showing of her collection..."Now & Then" exhibit Sept 13 through Oct 11, 1986 ... "

A high point of the evening was 30-35 blocks made over the years by Mrs Schafer for her friend, Cuesta Benberry. Merry Silber, curator of the show, arranged for them to be sent as a surprise.

When I first met Mary Schafer in the summer of '76, I spent several never-to-beforgotten days with her. We talked quilts from early morning till late and started again the next morning. I saw a house full of quilt related items - everthing from quilts to early quilt periodicals.
