Remember the quilt Mrs Hoover had made as a wedding gift for her son?

Mrs H A Tiedtke writes: "...In sending my renewal (to NEEDLECRAFT) I am availing myself of the privilege of 'talking back' as requested...In May 1926, there appeared an illustration and description of a quilt made for our present 'First Lady of the Land.' The writer of this article stated that 'the quilting was done in the south by an oldtime quilter, whereas Nebraska should have the credit. It is a small matter, of course, but it means much to the quilters, with whom I am well acquainted - they were so proud and glad of the privilege of doing this work on Mrs Hoover's quilt."
