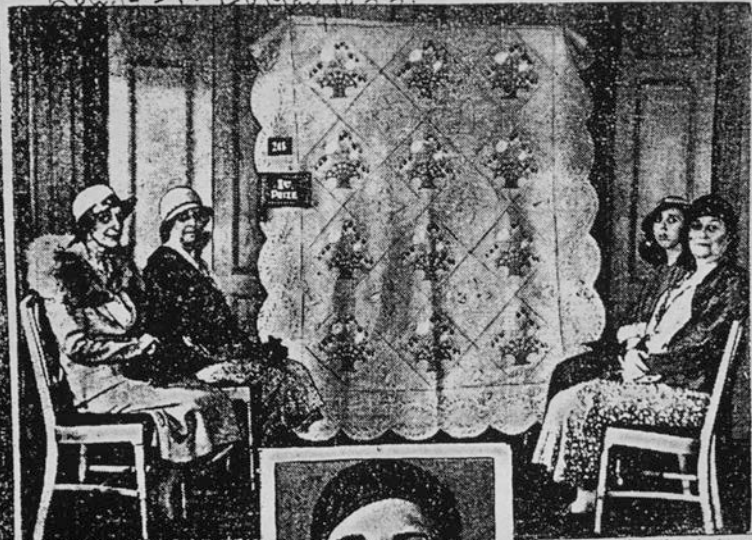


# Unemployed Seamstress' Quilt Wins First Prize In City Handiwork Contest
