

QUAKER BRIDES Quilt Pattern

The flowers are made using three shades of any selected color, green stems and leaves, with harmonizing bands. For example: flowers in shades of yellow to rust, brown centers, and yellow or green bands, or flowers in shades of blue, yellow centers, and blue bands. Finished size is about 84 by 102.

Yardage

- 9 yards of eggshell.
- 3 yards of green (for bands, leaves, and binding).
- 1 bolt Peter Pan bias for stemming (12 yards).
- 1/4 yard brown for centers.
- 1/2 yard of each of three shades for petals.

Measurement of Eggshell Background

1. Centerpiece	26x48
2. 1st side pieces	11x73
3. 1st end pieces	11x30
4. 2nd side pieces	12x98
5. 2nd end pieces	12x54

Measurement of Green Bands

1. 1st end pieces	26x2 1/2
2. 1st side pieces	53x2 1/2
3. 2nd end pieces	51x2 1/2
4. 2nd side pieces	77x2 1/2
5. 3rd end pieces	77x4
6. 3rd side pieces	108x4

The bias stemming from bands to the flowers measures 4", 4 1/4", and 5 inches.

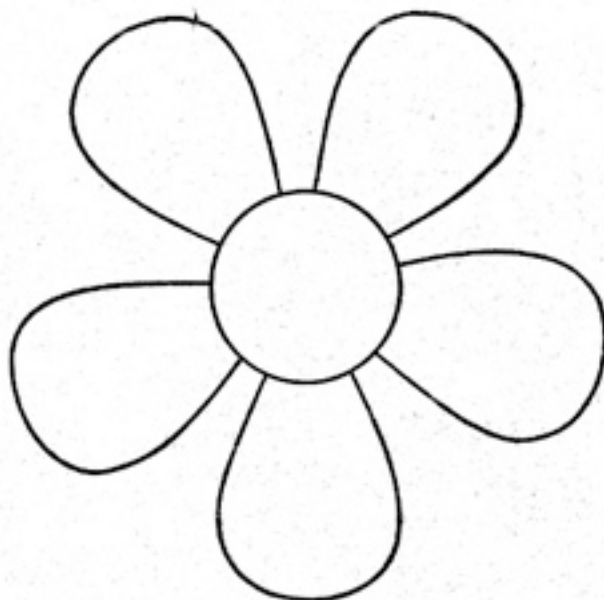
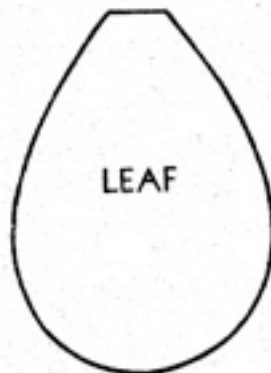


DIAGRAM OF ASSEMBLED BLOSSOM
