

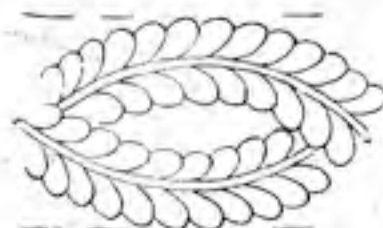
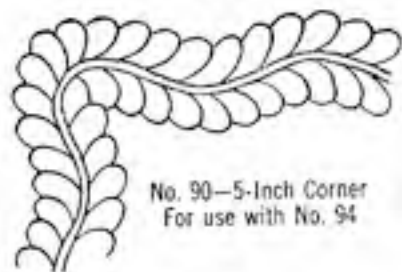
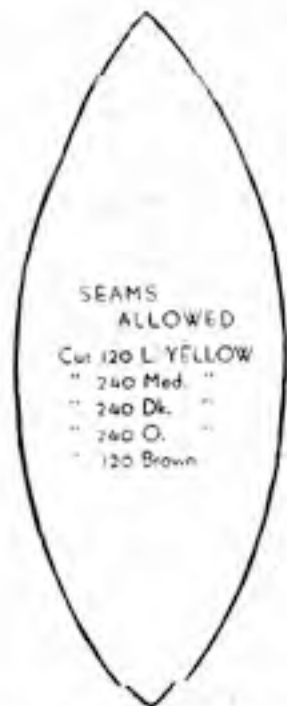
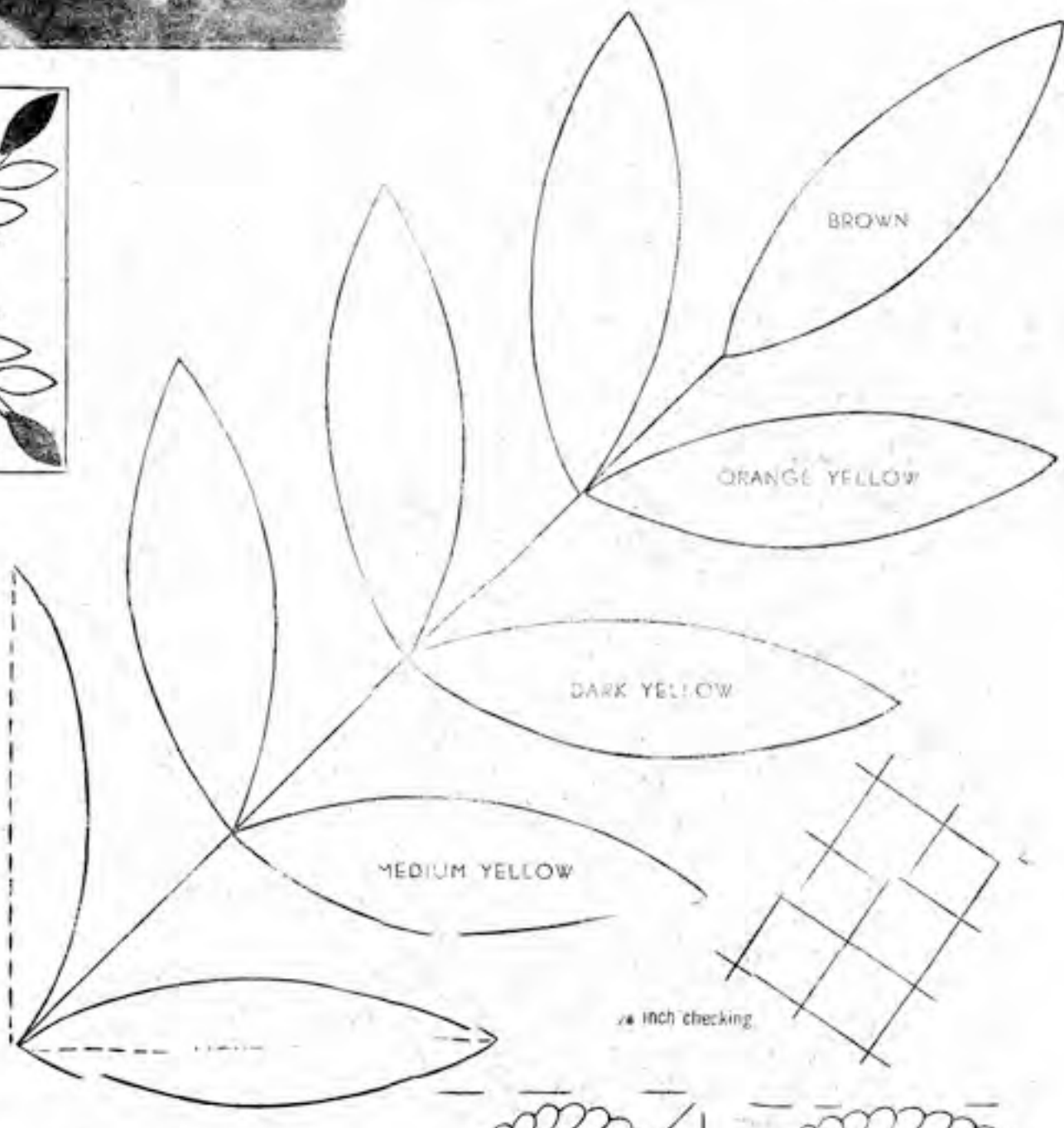
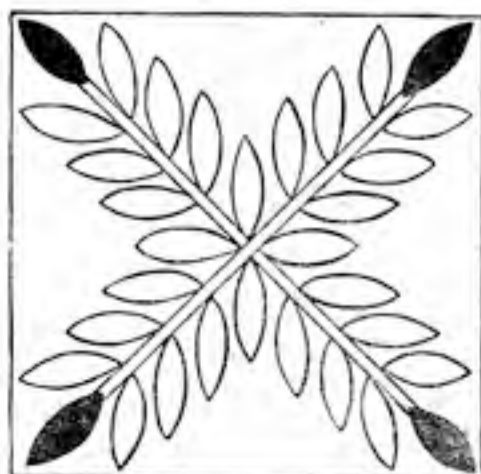


THE LAUREL Quilt Pattern

The Laurel: A very decorative design, simple to make, copied from a quilt made about one hundred years ago. Yardage requirements: 8 yds. eggshell, 34 yds. light yellow; 1 1/2 yds. each of the other yellows; 3 yds. brown; 2 - 12 yd. bolts 5/16" bias tape for stemming. Cut size: 90 x 108. Instructions: Cut twenty 18" background blocks (preferably of eggshell if the yellow combination is used.) The bias stemming is applied over the top of all the leaves except the brown. Add a brown band 1 1/2" wide and bind in brown. Tailored quilting is suggested for this design. Other color suggestions: Graduated shades of green from pale to rose-leaf green; tan, peach, and rust; or mile green background with white or eggshell leaves and stems.

Top 2 end borders 9" x 11" and 2 side borders 9" x 108". If you do not care to add an outside border band of corner oval, make the borders 12" x 74" and 12" x 108".



Suggested Quilting Instructions: Using Lockport's Two Star or Priscilla Cotton Batt, No. 8 or 9 Between Quilting Needle, with No. 70 quilting thread, quilt all around all applique leaves and stems keeping an even distance from the designs. In the center of the border use Lockport's continuous plume quilting stencil No. 94 with corner No. 90 as pictured. If you use the wider border you might prefer more elaborate quilting on the border so we suggest Lockport's stencil No. 89 with corner No. 101. Connect all designs with 1/4" square checking diamond style extending the checking to the edges of the quilt.

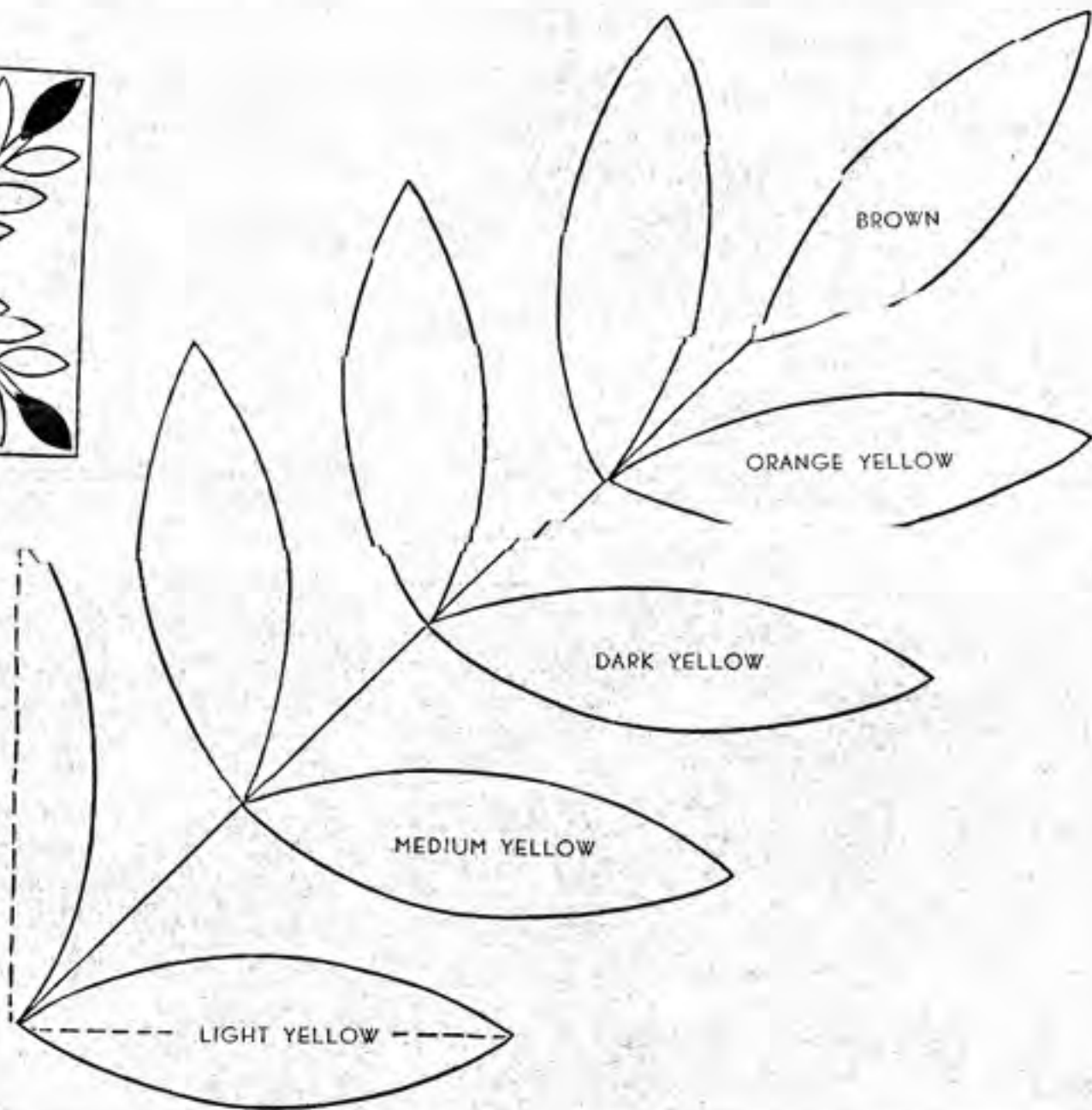
