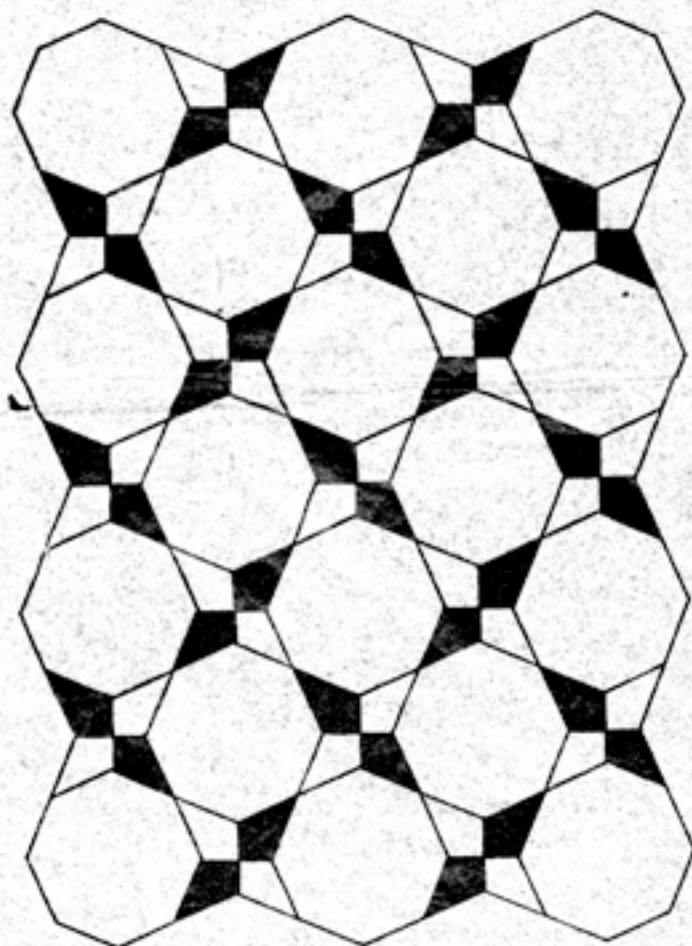


# HUMMING BIRD Quilt Pattern

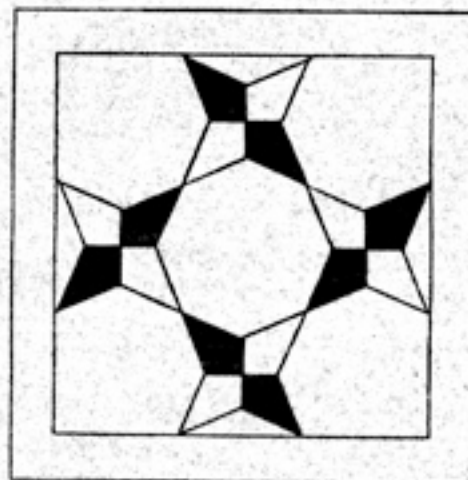
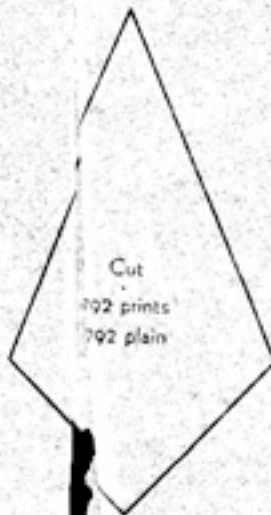
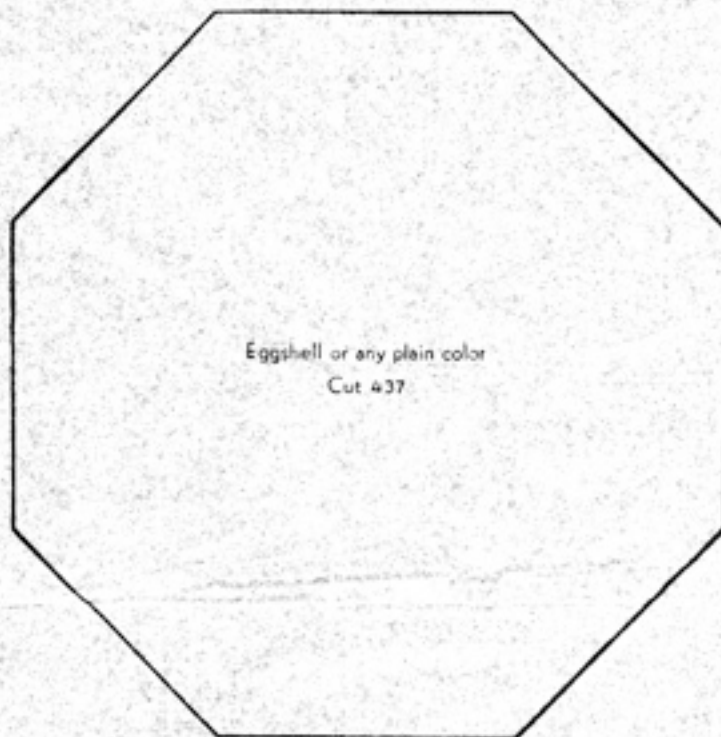
Pattern furnished through courtesy of the Mary A. Mc Elwain Quilt Shop, Walworth Wisconsin  
 There are 437 octagons in the quilt. They are set together with four of the smaller pieces, as shown in the diagram. The quilt is made 19 blocks wide and 23 blocks long, which will finish about 86" x 102," when seamed.

Yardage: 7 yards eggshell

Scraps of prints and plain colors for the smaller pieces.



This is a plan for setting the quilt together. The edges of the quilt are appliqued on an 8 inch border of plain used in octagons. Then bind the edge straight, in any color desired.



Plan for setting pillow together. A 2 inch band of either print or plain is put around the pillow.
