

POSTAGE STAMP Quilt Pattern

The chart below does not indicate all the rows in the quilt, but it shows how to proceed in making it. Refer to numbered list.

Make this quilt 88 blocks wide and 104 blocks long, then fill in the corners, repeating the run of colors in their order, making the quilt about 86" x 102" when finished. This quilt can be made smaller by reducing the number of rows to the desired size.

When sewing pieces together, leave the width of the seam open at each end. This leaves room to turn the edge under when the next block is fitted in.

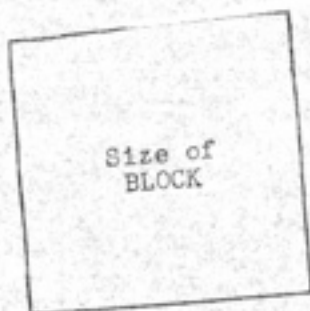
For patching, we use Stiles Wax Thread No. 70, and No. 10 Crewel needles. With the aid of these, you can do excellent work.
