## PATCHWORK QUILT DESIGN PATTERN

THIS PACKAGE CONTAINS ONE FULL SIZE PATTERN of each figure or flower, illustrated hereon, together WITH COMPLETE SIMPLE INSTRUCTIONS covering material required; how to cut it, also how to cut, arrange, baste and sew on every flower or figure including a diagram showing how many to cut and color of each.

Cut patterns exact size given, if basting. Allow  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch, if whipping, fold material twice, making four thicknesses. Lay pattern on, cut material on the bias, baste firmly, cut carefully, baste design on foundation. Have material and pattern perfectly smooth. Baste with all angles near the edge to prevent fraying. You need not remove stitches.

## No. 1212 French Basket

Cut one length white 2 yards long, 1 yard wide for center. Sew a strip 10 inches wide, 2 yards long to each side. Place four baskets in center. Basket is made of bias strips  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch wide. Cut 2 lengths 18 inches wide and  $2\frac{2}{3}$  yards long for sides of border; 2 lengths  $2\frac{1}{8}$  yards long, 18 inches wide.

Miter corners—then use No. 19 for shaping, 3 festoons on each side and 2 at ends.

### MATERIALS.

To insure best results you should use a good quality of full mercerized sateen, which is usually obtainable from any first-class dealer in drygoods.
