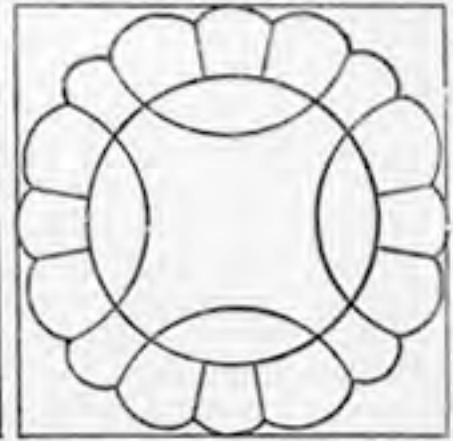

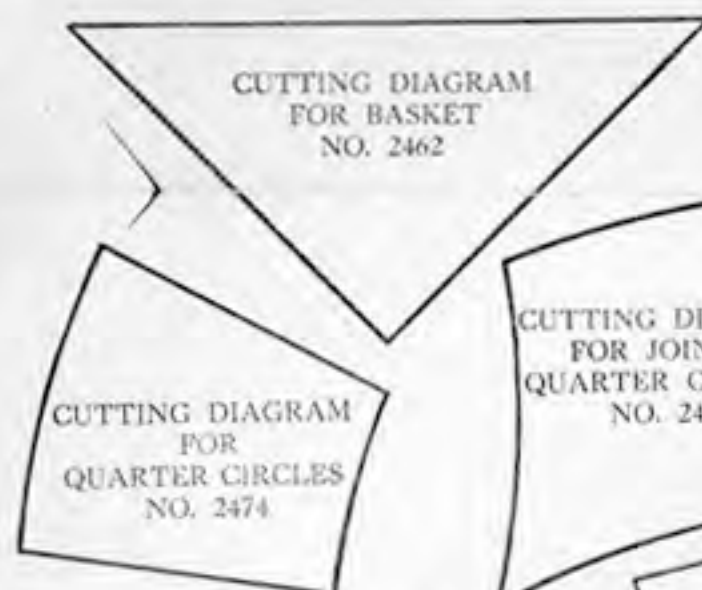

# LACE COLLARS AND CUFFS



## DIRECTIONS FOR COLLAR AND CUFF SET No. 2893

**Material:** Dexter Lustrous Cordonnet Crochet Cotton, 4 balls White No. 600 size 30. Virginia Snow Crochet Hook Size 9.

Ch 164, turn, and make 2 t c in 4th st from hook. \*1 t c in next st, 2 t c in next st, repeat from \* across. Ch 5, turn.

2nd row. 1 t c in each st of previous row. Ch 5, turn.

3rd row. 1 t c in each of next 4 t c, ch 5 to count as 1 st. \*1 knot st (to make knot st, draw loop on hook out  $\frac{1}{2}$  of an inch, ch 1, s c over single loop at left side of the st just made). Skip 2 t c, 1 s c in next st, 1 knot st, skip 2 t c, 1 t c in each of next 2 sts, skip 2 t c, 2 t c in next st, ch 2, 2 t c in same st, skip 2 t c, 1 t c in each of next 2 sts, repeat from \* across ending row with 2 knot sts and 1 t c in each of next 4 sts, ch 5, turn.

4th row. 4 t c in 4 t c, \*1 knot st, 1 s c in loop of 1st knot st, 2 knot sts, catch down with s c in loop of 2nd knot st below, 1 knot st, 1 t c in next 2 t c, make a shell of 2 t c, ch 2, 2 t c in shell below, 1 t c in each of 2 t c, beside shell. Repeat from \* across, ending with 4 t c. Ch 5, turn.

5th row. Same as 3rd row, only make 2 knot sts instead of 1, and catch down with 2 s c in knot st below.

6th row. Same as row 4. Always end row with 4 t c, ch 5, turn.

7th row. Same as row 5. Ch 5, turn.

8th row. Same as row 4. Ch 5, turn.

9th row. 4 t c, \*1 knot st, catch with s c, 2 knot sts, 2 s c, 2 knot sts, 2 s c, 1 knot st, 2 t c, shell in shell, 2 t c, repeat from \* across. Ch 5, turn.

10th row. 4 t c, \*2 knot sts, 2 s c, 2 knot sts, 2 s c, 2 knot sts, 2 t c, shell in shell, 2 t c, repeat from \* across. Ch 5, turn.

11th row. 4 t c, \*1 knot st, 2 s c, 2 knot sts, 2 s c, 2 knot st, 2 s c, 1 knot st, 2 t c, shell in shell, 2 t c, repeat from \* across. Ch 2, turn.

12th row. 4 d c, \*1 knot st, 2 s c, 2 knot st, 2 s c, 2 knot st, 2 d c, shell of 2 t c, pivot, 2 t c, 2 d c, repeat from \* across. Kned with 4 d c, break thread.

Work 1 s c in each st at neck edge (164 sts). Ch 5, turn, 1 d c in each, increasing 5 times in row. Repeat last 2 rows 5 times, ending with a c row. Work 3 loops for buttonholes on one side of collar.

**Buttons:** Ch 2, join in ring, make 5 s c in ring. Then 1 s c in each st, then 1 in each st, stuff with cotton and slip st to close, skipping every 2nd st. Sew to collar.

**Cuffs:** Ch 66, 2 t c in 6th st from hook, \*1 t c in each of next 2 sts, 2 t c in next st, repeat from \* across. Ch 5, turn.

2nd row. 4 t c in each of next 4 sts, (ch 5 to count as 1 st), \*1 knot st, skip 2 t c, 1 s c in next st, 1 knot st, skip 2 t c, 2 t c in each of next 2 st, skip 2 t c, shell of 2 t c, ch 2, 2 t c in next st, skip 2 t c, 2 t c in each of next 2 sts, repeat from \* across, ending row with 4 t c, ch 5, turn.

3rd row. 4 t c, \*1 knot st, catch with s c in loop of st below, 1 knot st, catch with s c in next loop, 1 knot st, 2 t c, shell, 2 t c, repeat from \* across.

4th row. 4 t c, \*2 knot sts, catch with 2 s c in loops below, 2 knot sts, 2 t c, shell, 2 t c, repeat from \* across.

Repeat rows 2 and 4 until there are 5 rows of knot sts.

10th row. 4 d c, \*1 knot st, 2 s c, 2 knot st, 2 s c, 1 knot st, 2 d c, shell of 2 t c, pivot, 2 t c, 2 d c, repeat from \* across. Break thread. Finish other end of cuff same as neck edge of collar, but have only 3 rows d c instead of 5.

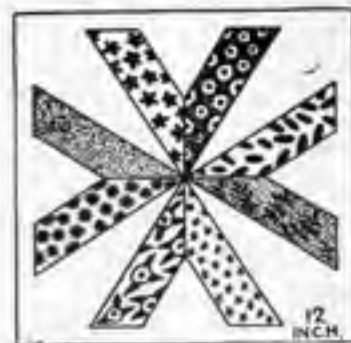


## DEXTER CORDONNET CROCHET COTTON "Never Kinks—Always Lies Flat"

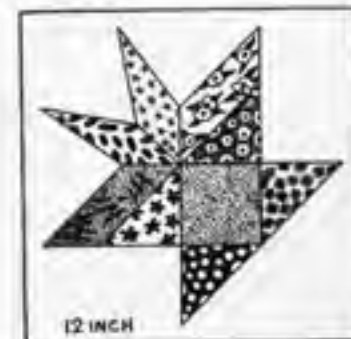

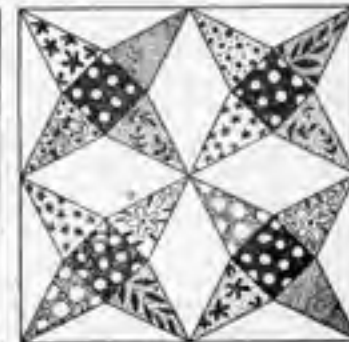
