Georgia's foremost quilt photographer, Bill Weinraub photographed more than 8500 quilts and designed equipment to meet on-site needs of the Georgia Quilt Project. Before his untimely death, he had completed photography for the upcoming book, *Georgia Quilts: Piecing Together a History*.

His photographs of 397 quilts made by Georgia quilt-makers for the 1996 Atlanta Olympics appeared in the book *The Olympic Games Gift Quilts: America's Welcome to the World* as well as calendars and magazines.

Trained as a mechanical engineer, Bill Weinraub's career path included blacksmithing, fiber optic cable research, and real estate investing. Remembered by the Georgia Quilt Project as a skilled and dedicated quilt photographer, he was also a loving husband and devoted father to Anita and Stephanie Weinraub.

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
